#### **AGENDA ITEM NO. 16 : Consideration and Approval of the Course Relevance with Employability, Entrepreneurship, and Skill Development (2018-19).**

##### **Points Discussed:**

Dr. N.C. Pahadia, President, initiated the discussion by emphasizing the urgent need to align the current course syllabi with the evolving demands of employability, entrepreneurship, and skill development. He highlighted that rapid changes in industry trends and the growing focus on entrepreneurial ventures make it essential for the university to regularly review and update the curriculum. This alignment is crucial for preparing students to succeed in a dynamic job market while also equipping them with the necessary entrepreneurial skills to explore new opportunities.

Members engaged in a detailed discussion on the need to incorporate practical skills, industry-relevant projects, and modern teaching methodologies into the syllabus to ensure students gain the competencies required to excel in a competitive environment. The Council also stressed the importance of integrating emerging technologies, fostering innovation, and promoting creativity through entrepreneurship-oriented programs. Furthermore, internships, workshops, and collaborations with industry partners were highlighted as key components to enhance practical exposure and skill development among students.
