- To foster a culture of **mutual respect**, inclusion, and empowerment.

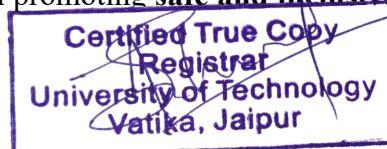
Resource Person:

- Real-life case studies and reflections on promoting **safe and inclusive environments**.

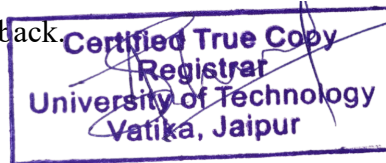


Participants:

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REPORT ON INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY CELEBRATION

Introduction:

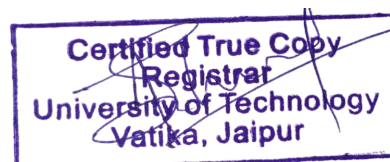
She lauded the efforts, dedication, and achievements of students who had successfully qualified for **NET and JRF examinations**, and personally handed over **certificates of achievement** to them.

6. Vote of Thanks:

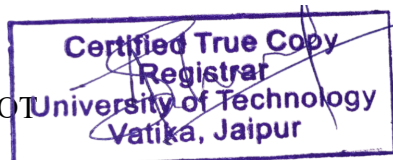
