Inaugural Session:

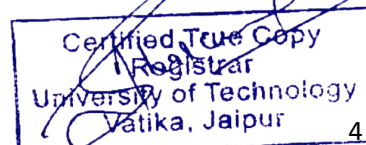

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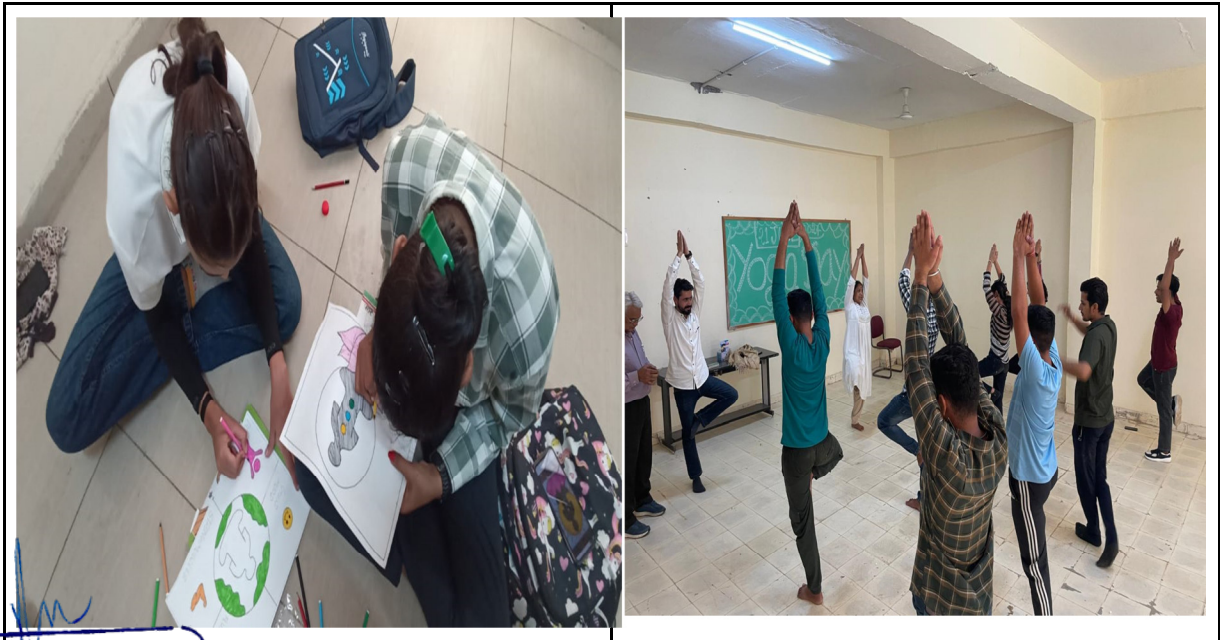
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Celebrates International Yoga Day on 21/06/2024
