An instructor can earn income by sharing a percentage of the course price after selling the course on this platform. 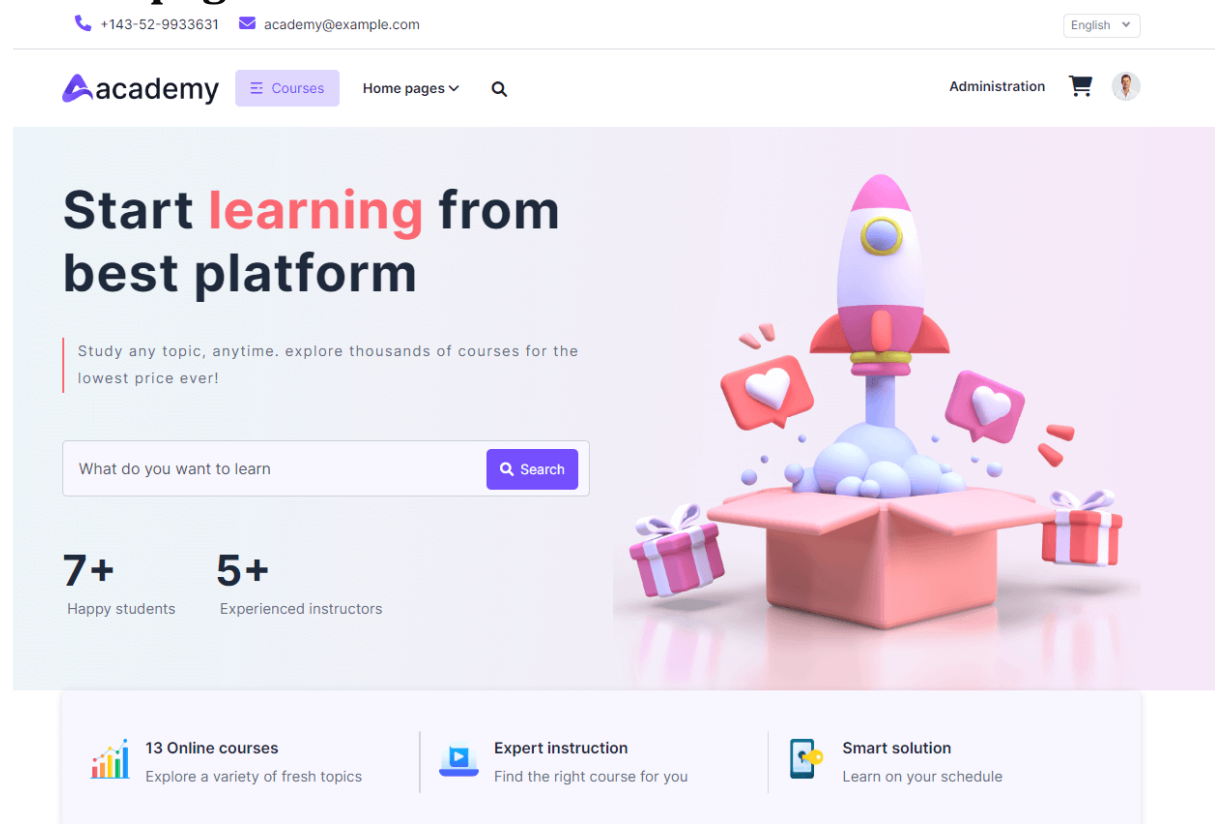


Figure 1. University of Technology LMS Frontend Homepage

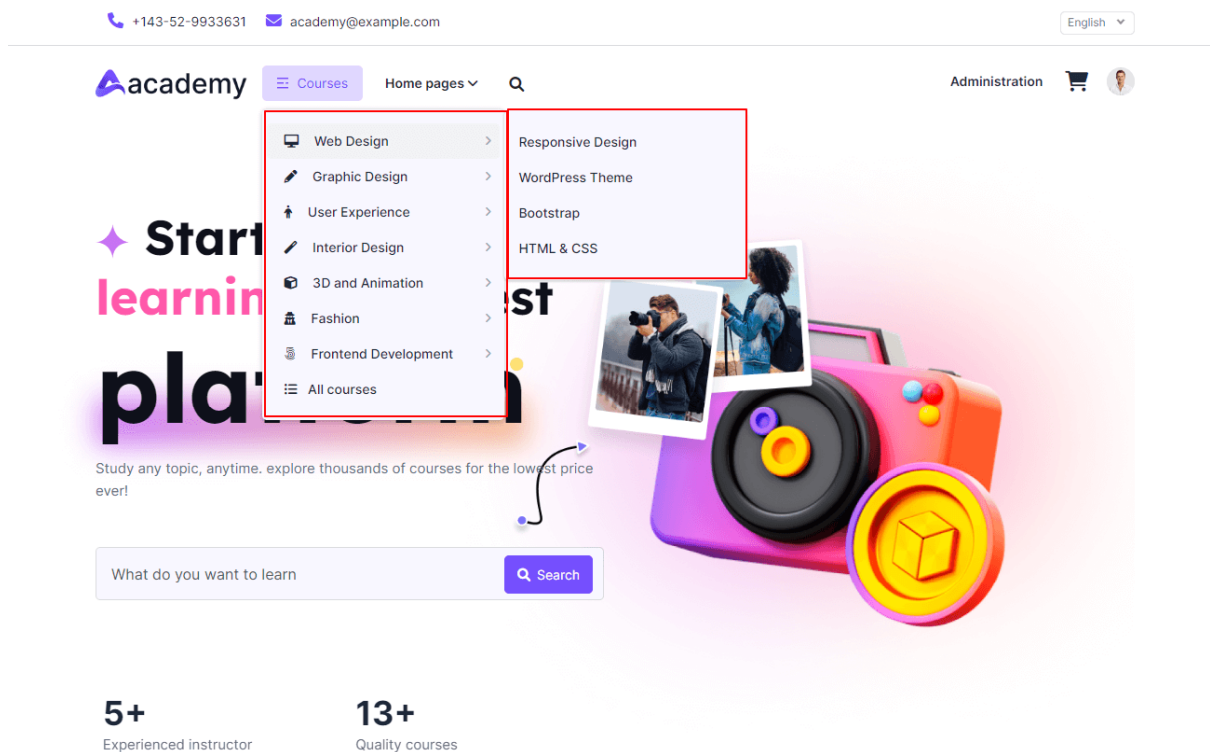


Figure 2. University of Technology LMS Frontend Course Category Menu

Course Search bar

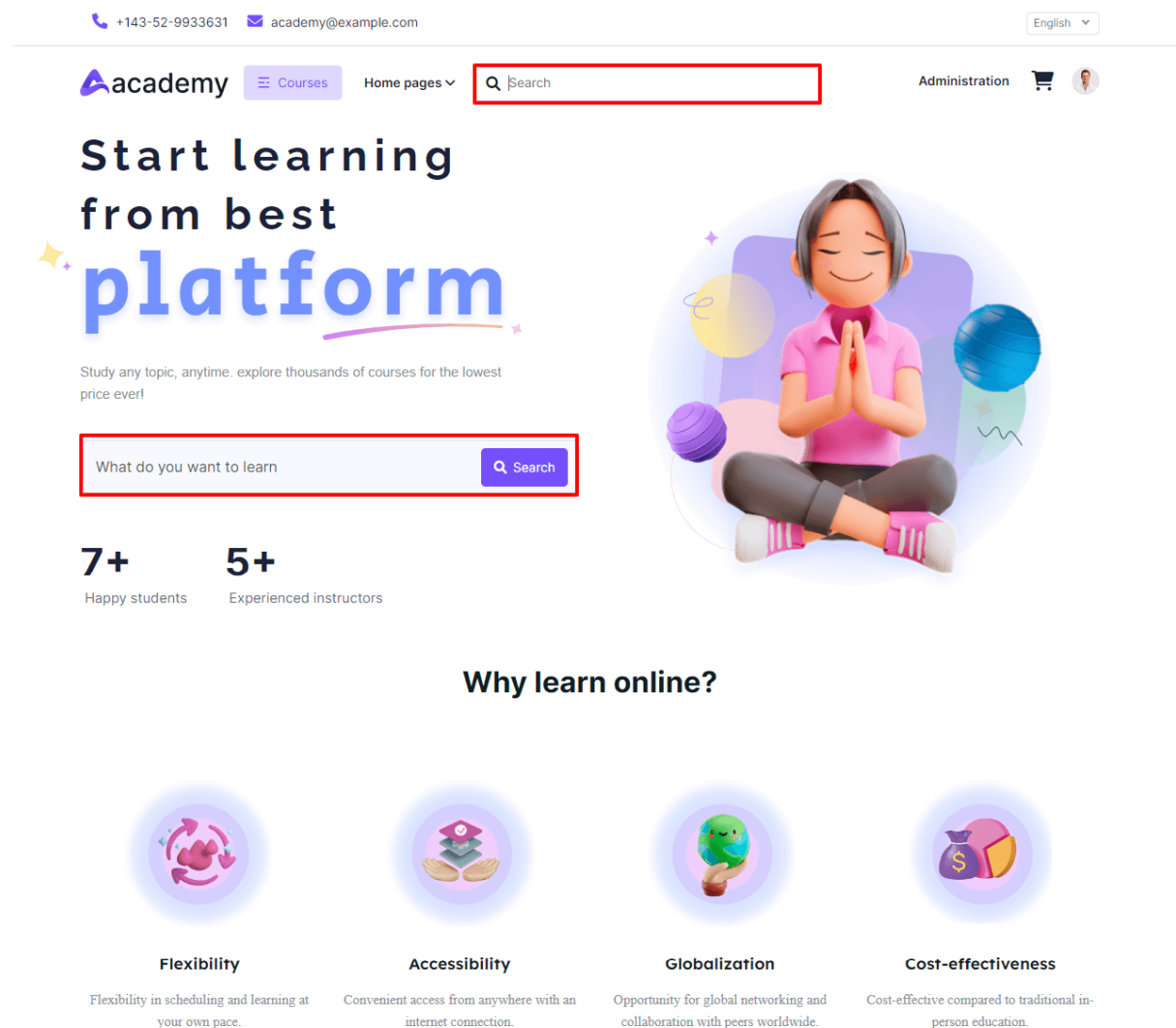


Figure 3. University of Technology LMS Frontend search bar

Cart page

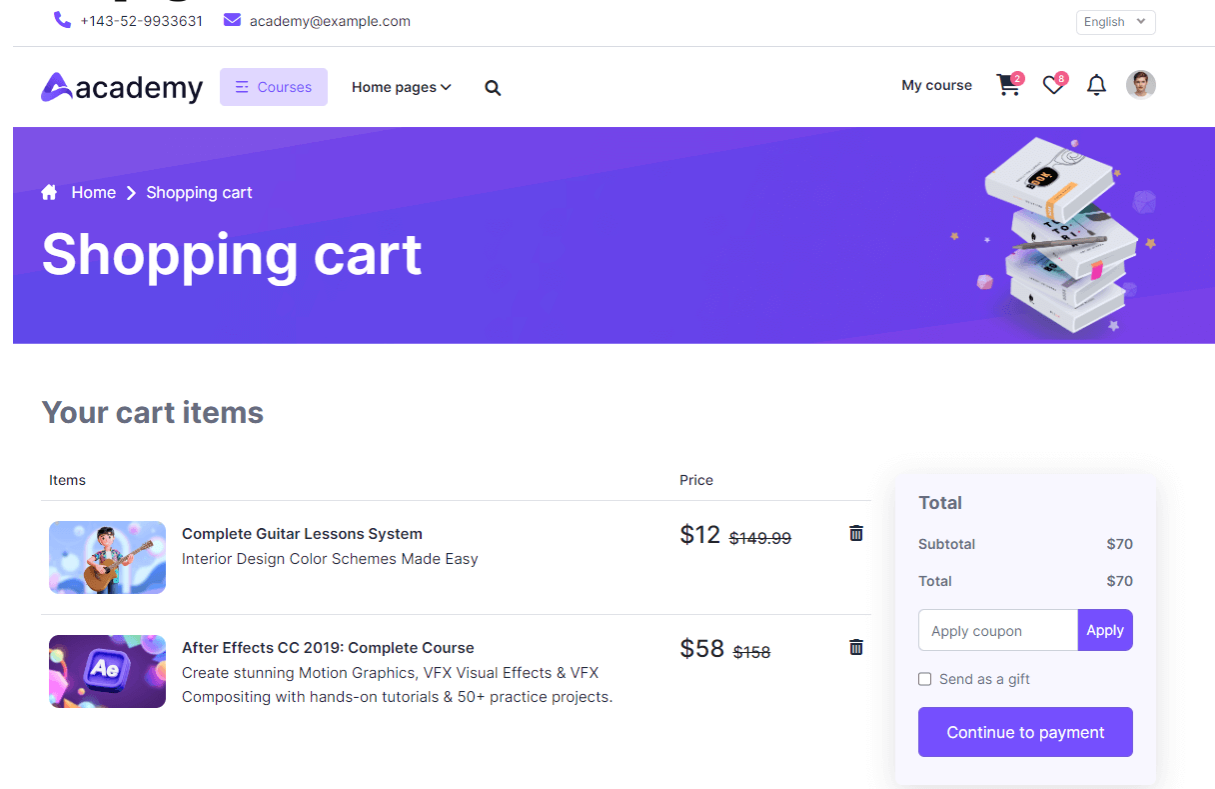


Figure 4. University of Technology LMS Frontend Shopping Cart

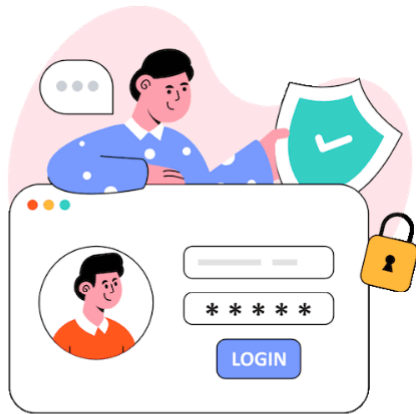

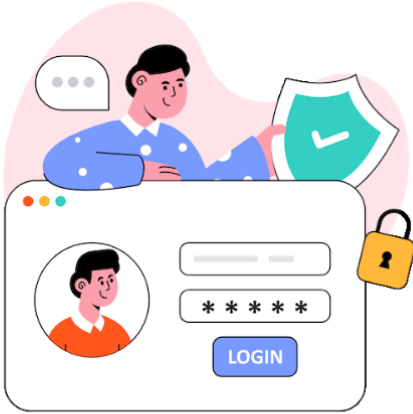

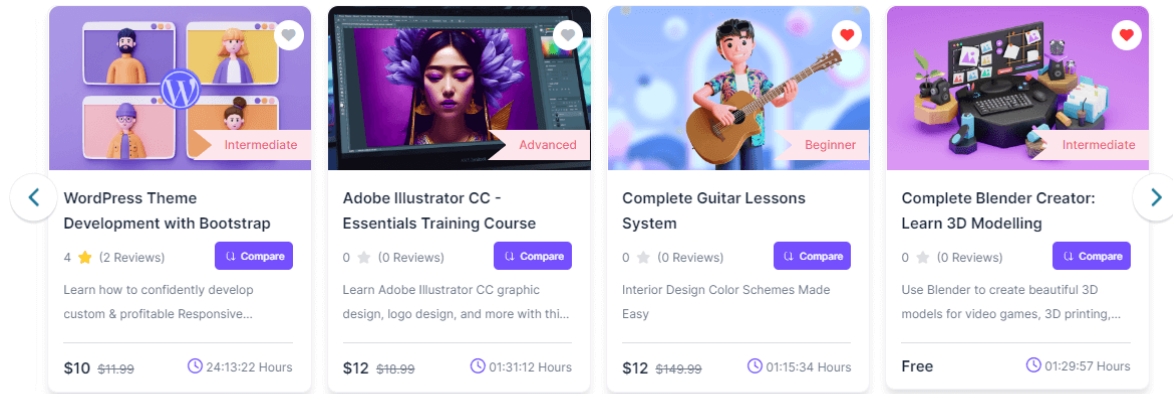


Figure 7. University of Technology LMS Top Course

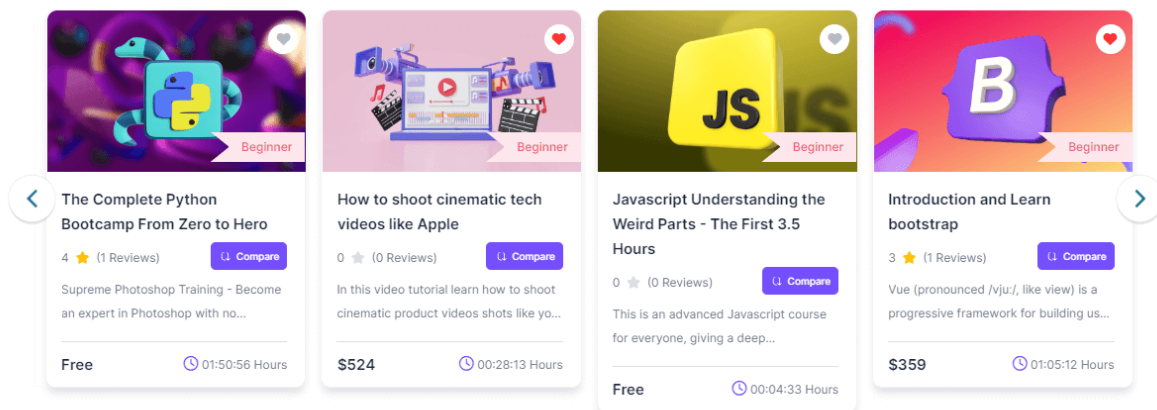


Figure 8. University of Technology LMS Latest Course

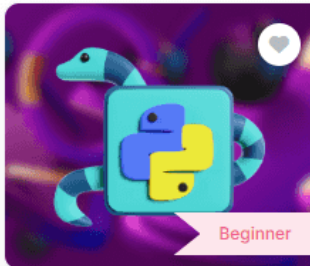
Figure 9. University of Technology LMS Course Filter Page

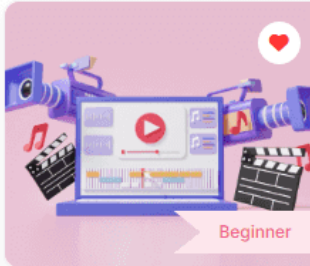

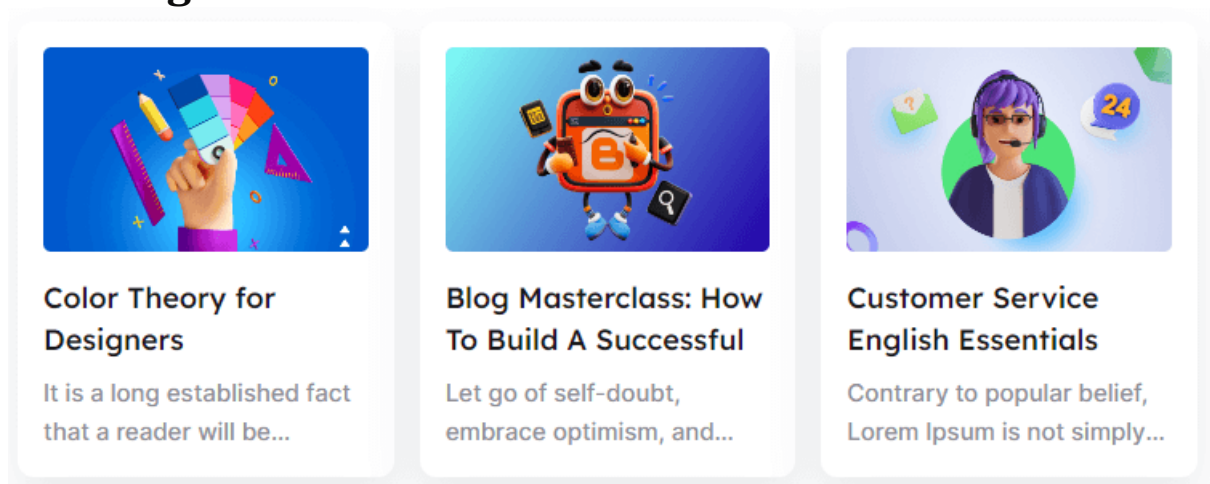


Figure 11. University of Technology LMS Course Grid

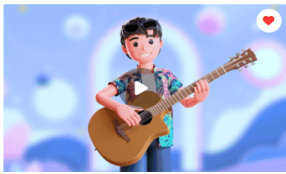

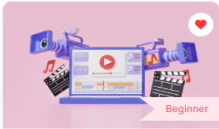

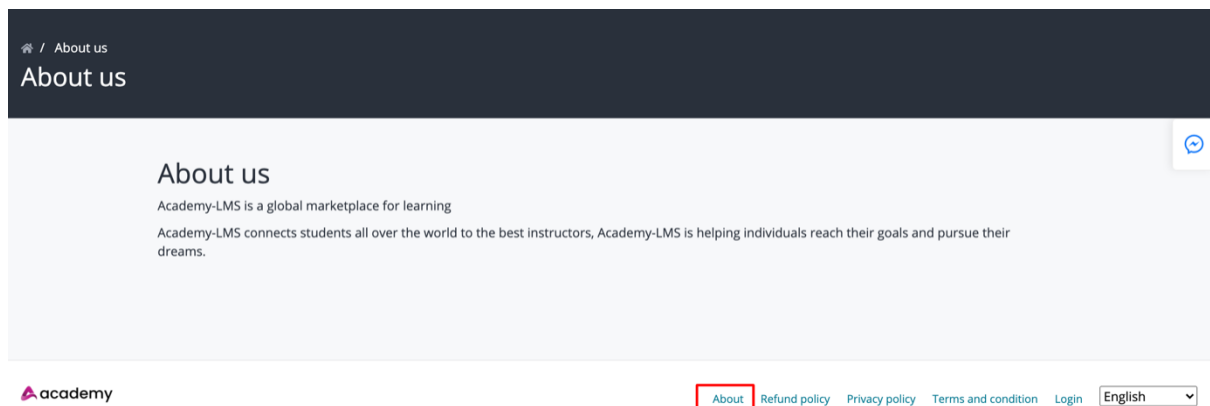


Figure 13. University of Technology LMS About Page

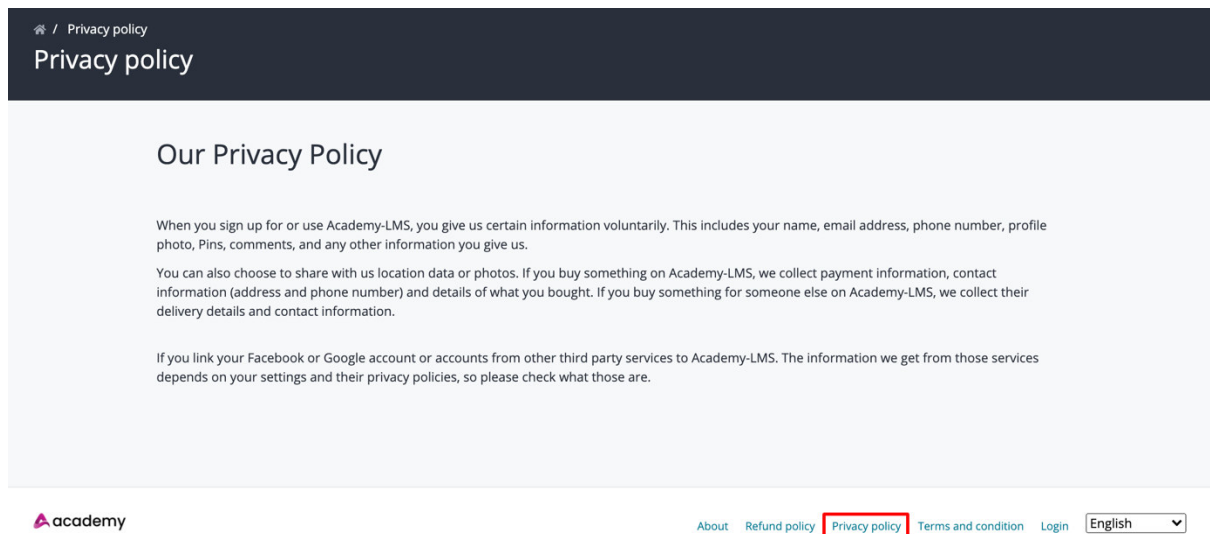


Figure 15. University of Technology LMS Frontend Privacy Policy

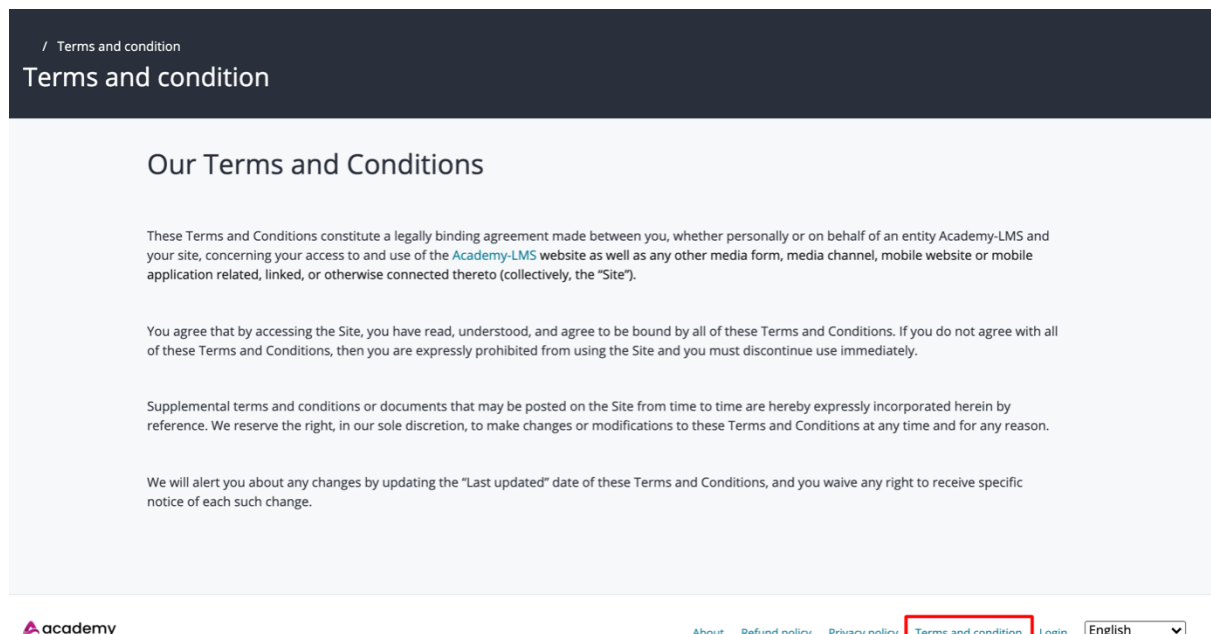


Figure 16. University of Technology LMS Frontend Terms and Conditions

Provide the required information to create a course. Which are:

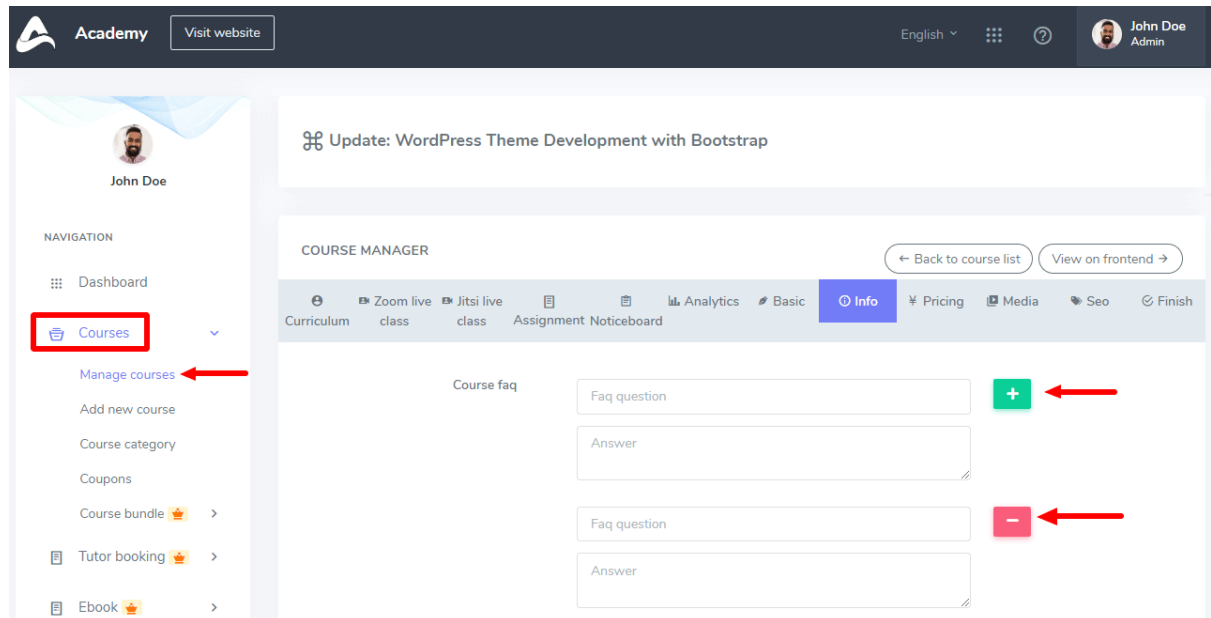

- Top course selection checkbox

After providing the info, click on the "**Green right arrow**" for the next step.

- Navigate to the course managing option.
- Select the "Info" option.
- Add common questions and answers in the "Course FAQ" section.
- Click on the "+" button to add multiple FAQs and "-" for removing a FAQ.

② How to update the application version

- ✚ Before updating to the new version, make sure that you currently running its previous version. For example, you can not directly update your version 5.9 from 5.5. First, you have to update 5.6 from 5.5, then you have to update 5.7 from 5.6, then update 5.8, and then you can update 5.9. You have to follow the sequence of the number to update the application version. Just like $5.5 > 5.6 > 5.7 > 5.8 > 5.9$

- ✚ If you want to build your own website/course portal/project, you can purchase the regular license for each project. Or, if you want to build a website/course portal/project for others/your clients, you have to purchase the extended license for each project.

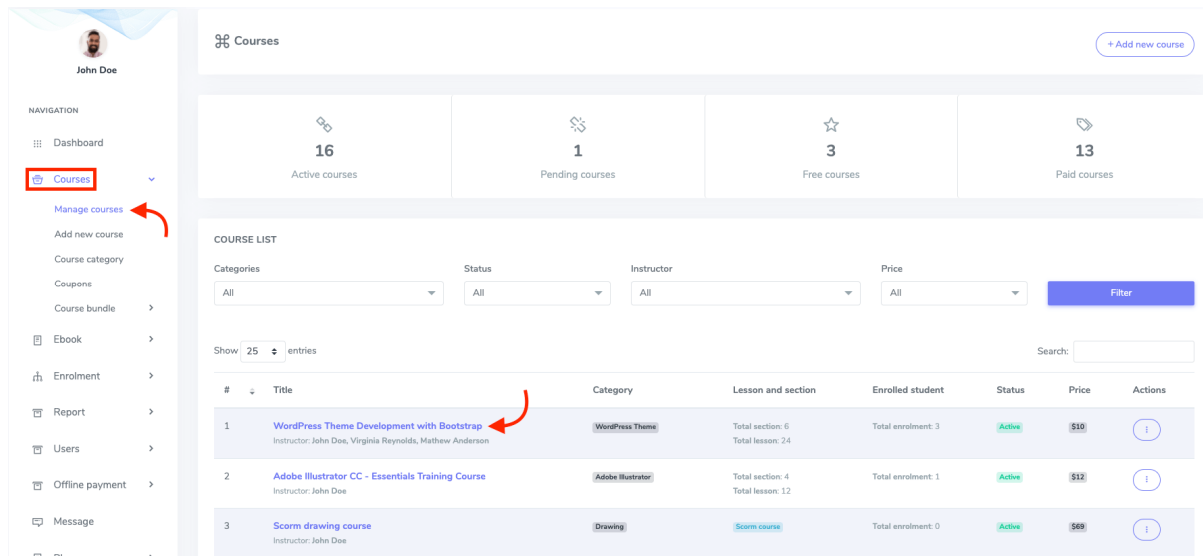


Figure 1. University of Technology LMS Managing A Course Lesson

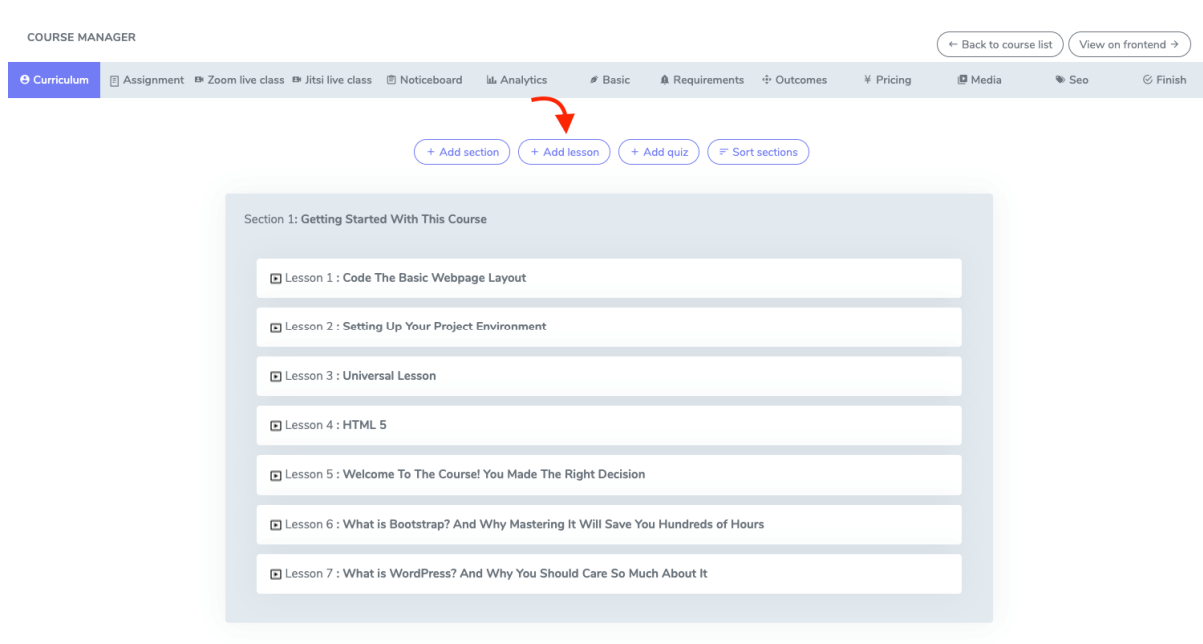


Figure 2. University of Technology LMS Adding A Lesson

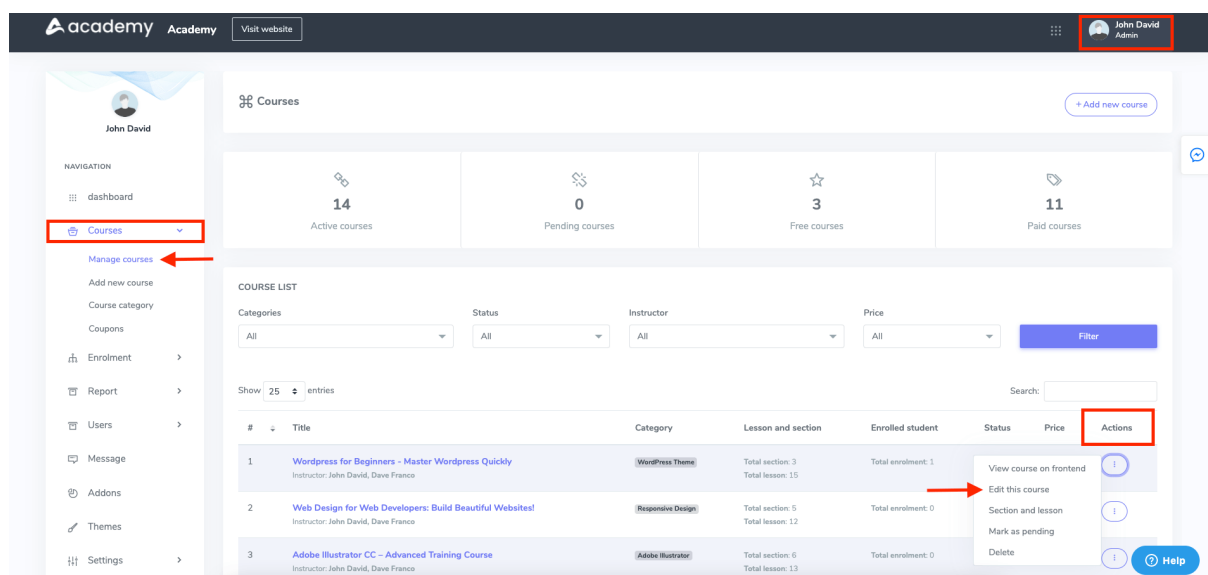


Figure 1. University of Technology LMS Managing A Course (Admin)

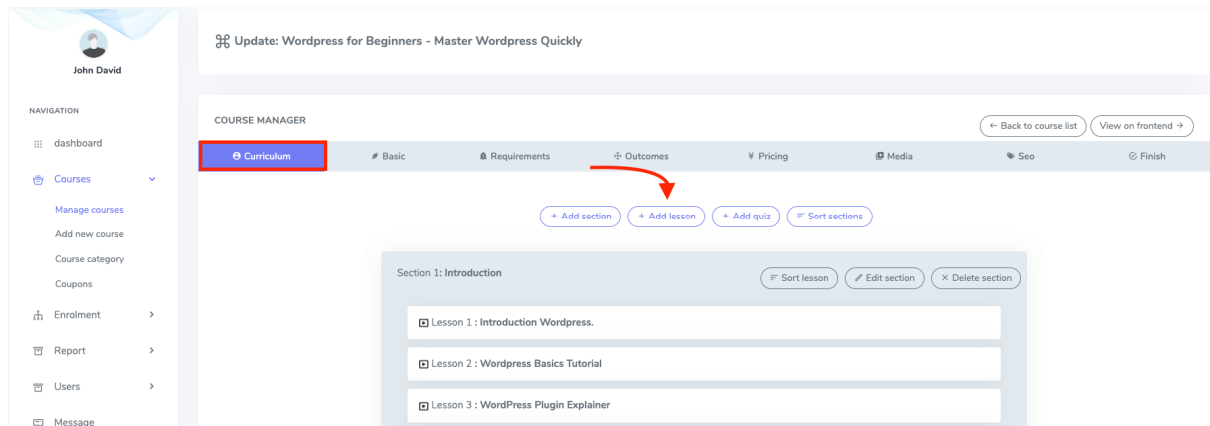


Figure 2. University of Technology LMS Adding Lesson (Admin)

Amazon S3 Bucket

Amazon S3 bucket is an addon. After installing this addon to your application, you will get this option in the "**Select lesson type**" form. To add an Amazon S3 Bucket lesson, you have to provide the following information:

Instructor panel:

4. Click on the "**Add lesson**" button from the "**Curriculum**" form.

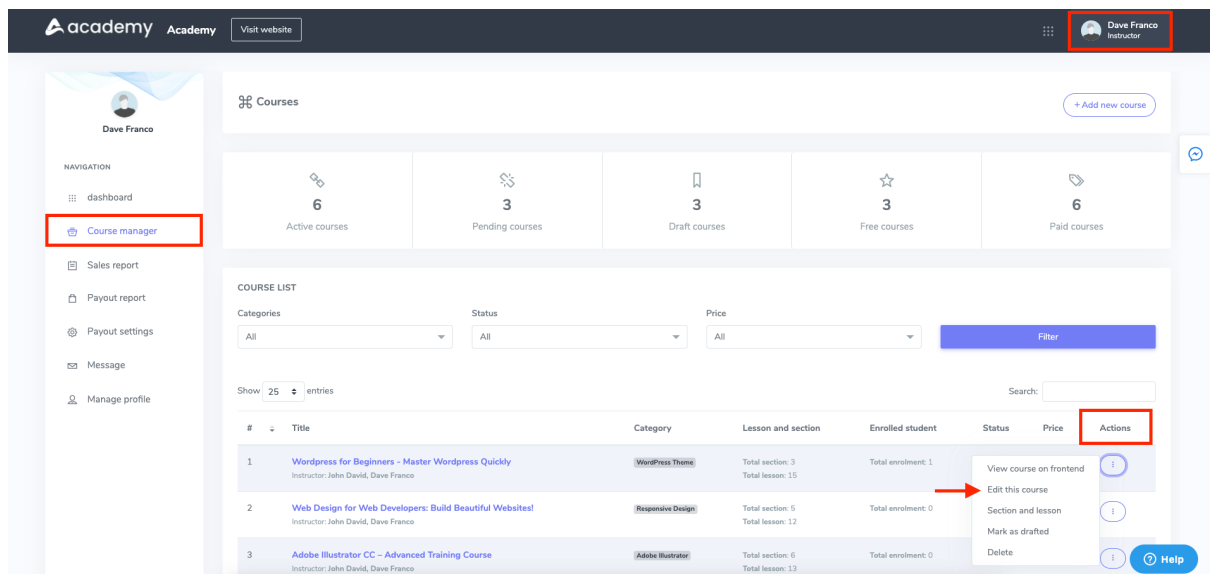


Figure 4. University of Technology LMS Managing A Course Lesson (Instructor)

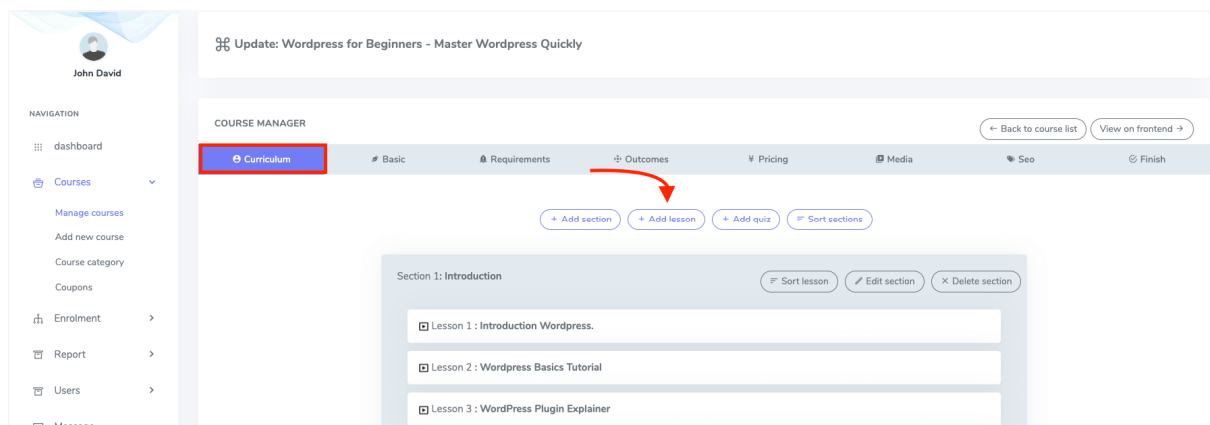


Figure 5. University of Technology LMS Adding A Lesson (Instructor)

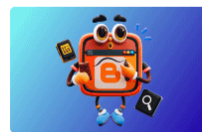

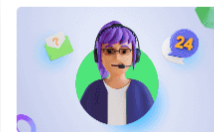

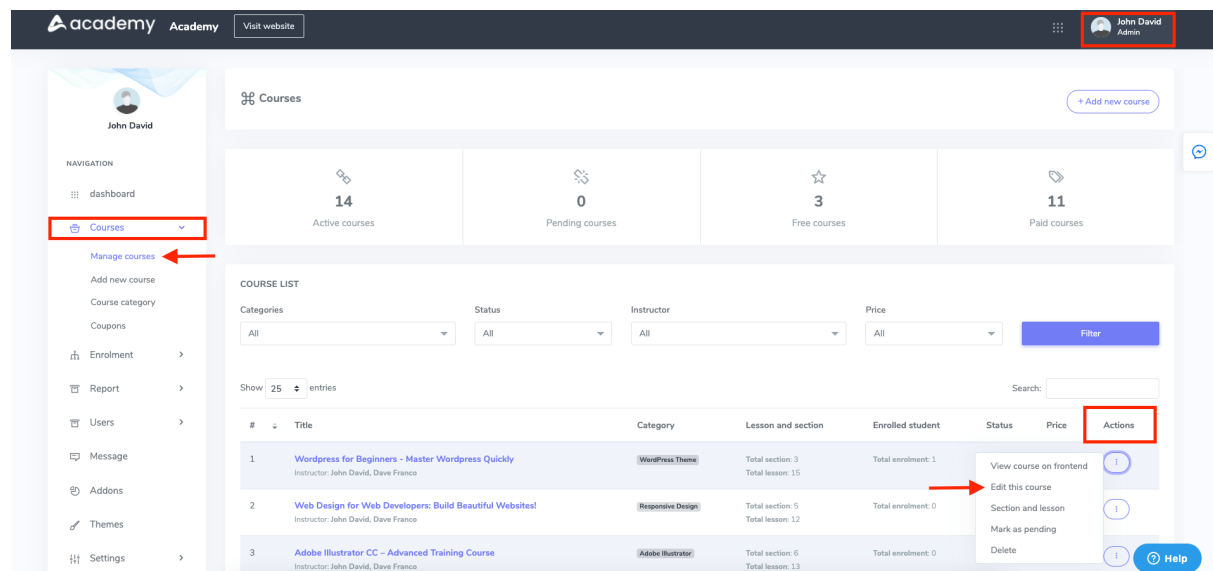


Figure 1. University of Technology LMS Managing Course

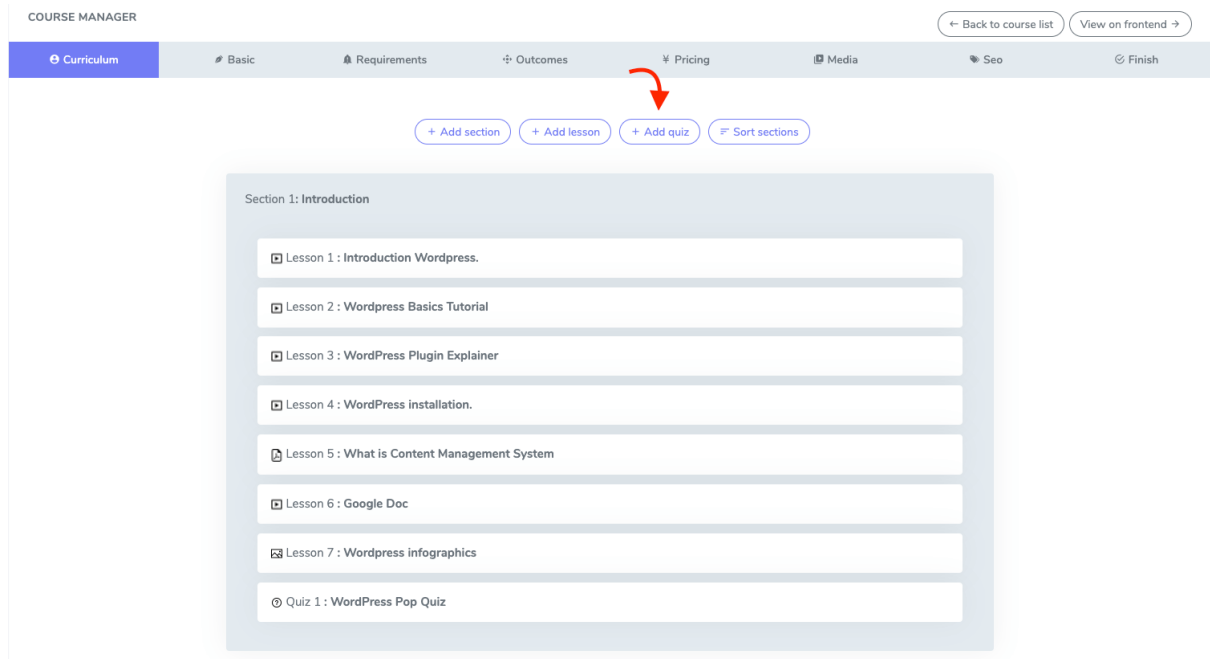


Figure 2. University of Technology LMS Adding Quiz

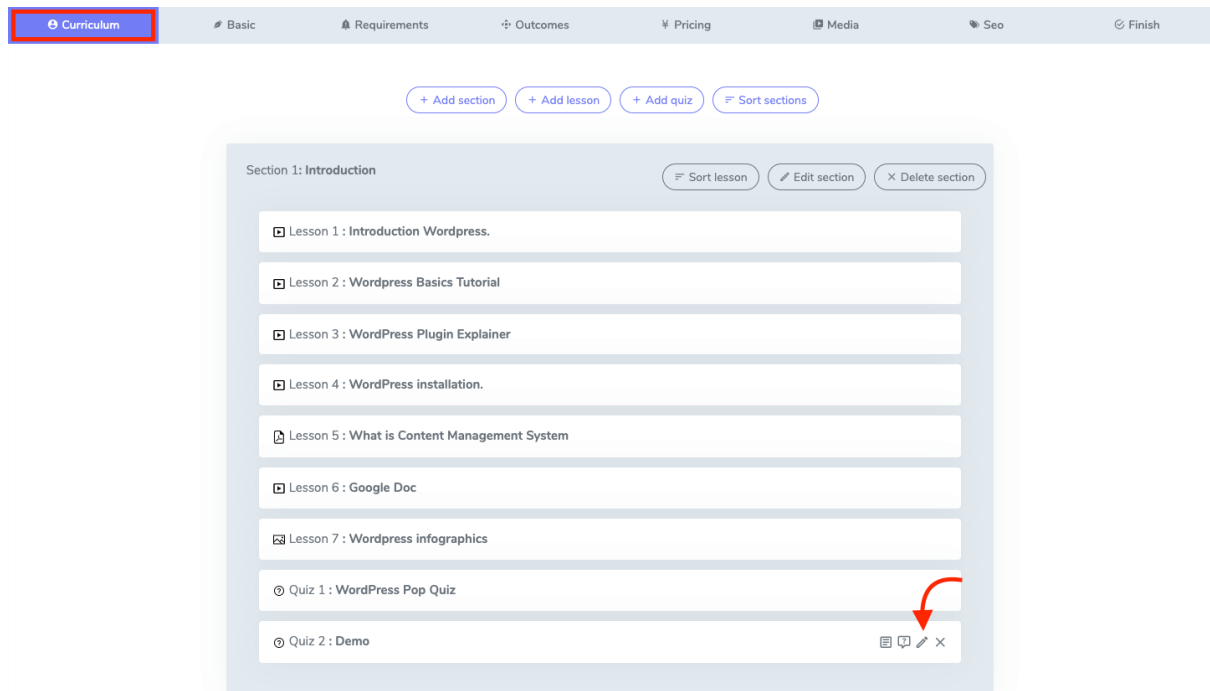


Figure 4. University of Technology LMS Editing A Quiz

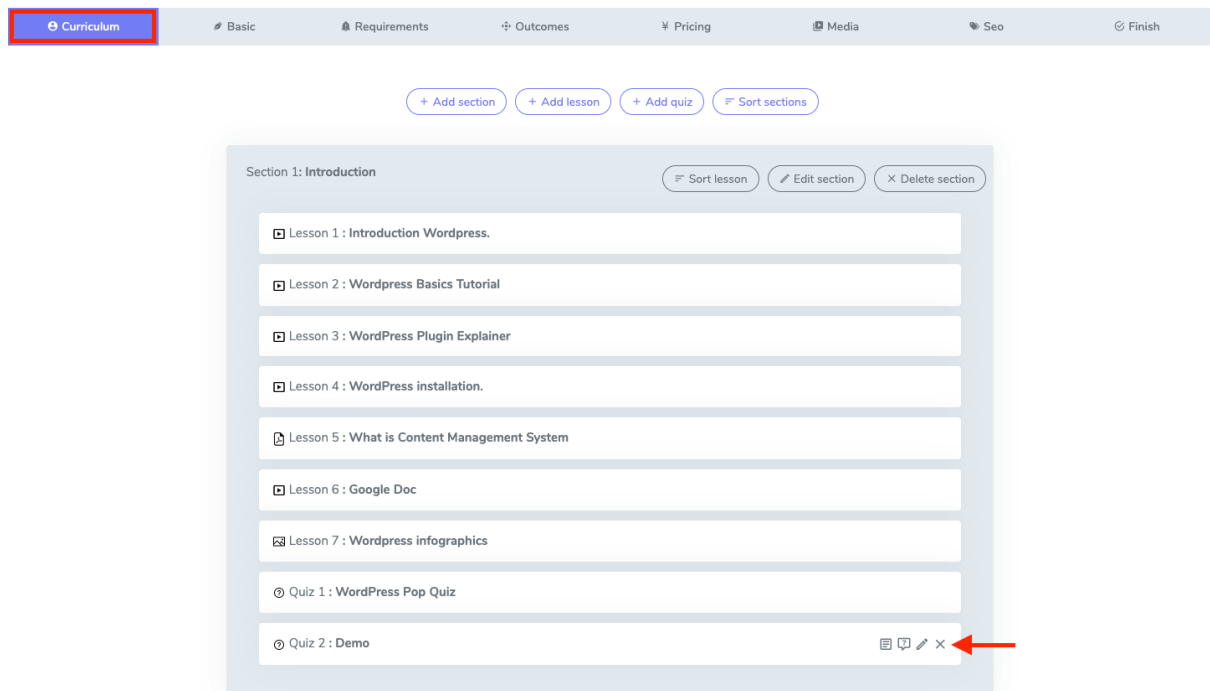


Figure 6. University of Technology LMS Deleting A Quiz

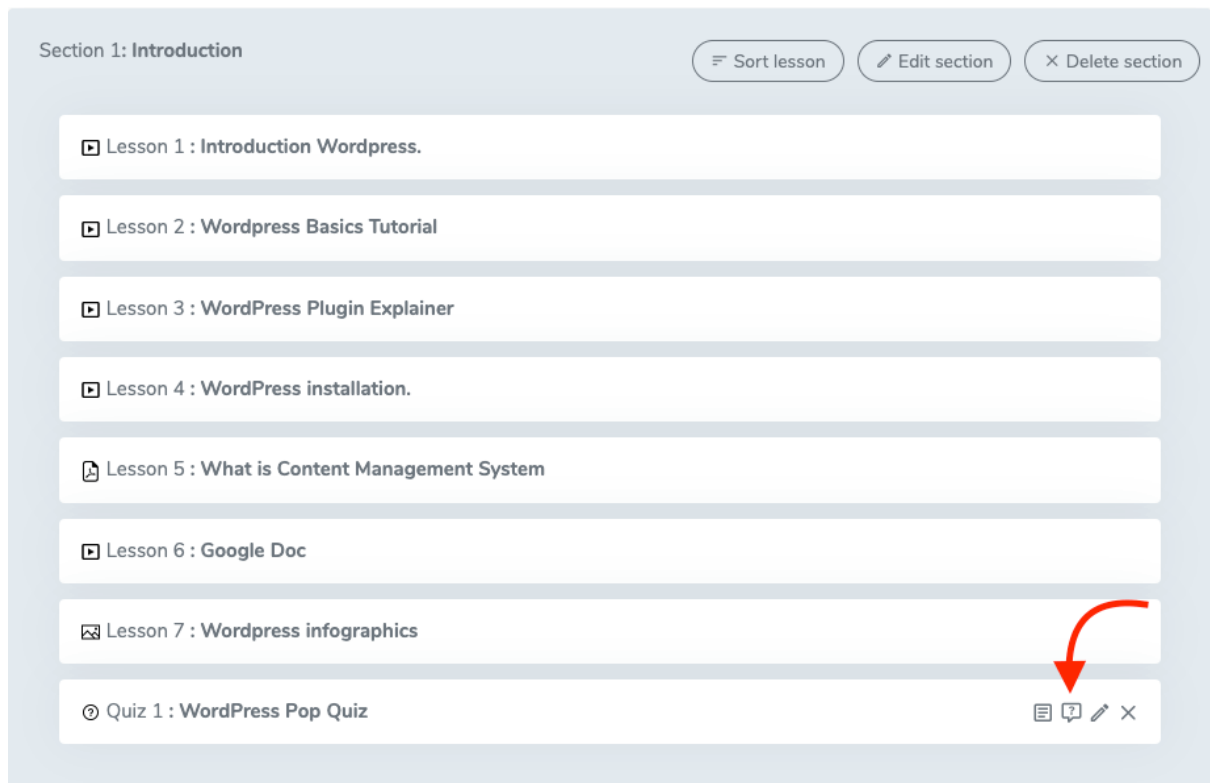


Figure 7. University of Technology LMS Quiz Question

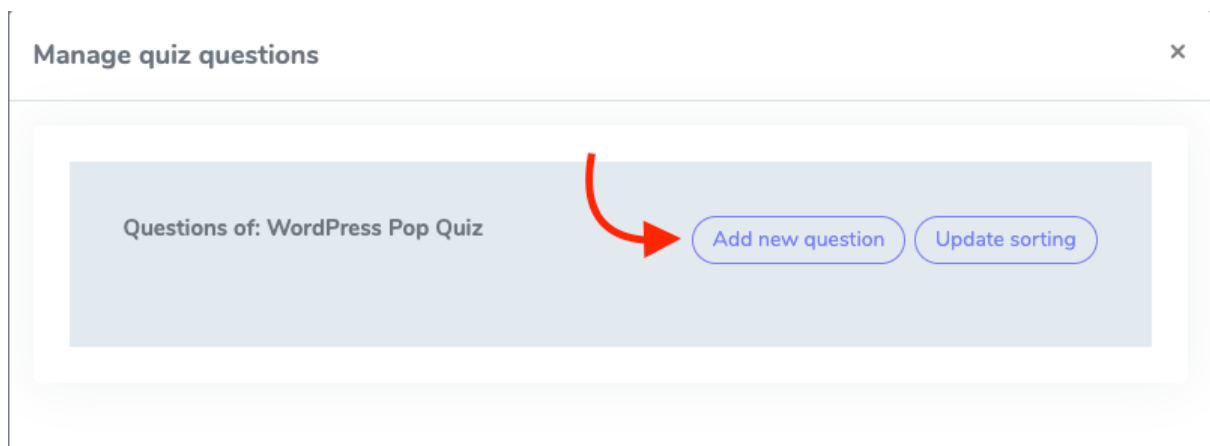


Figure 8. University of Technology LMS Adding New Quiz

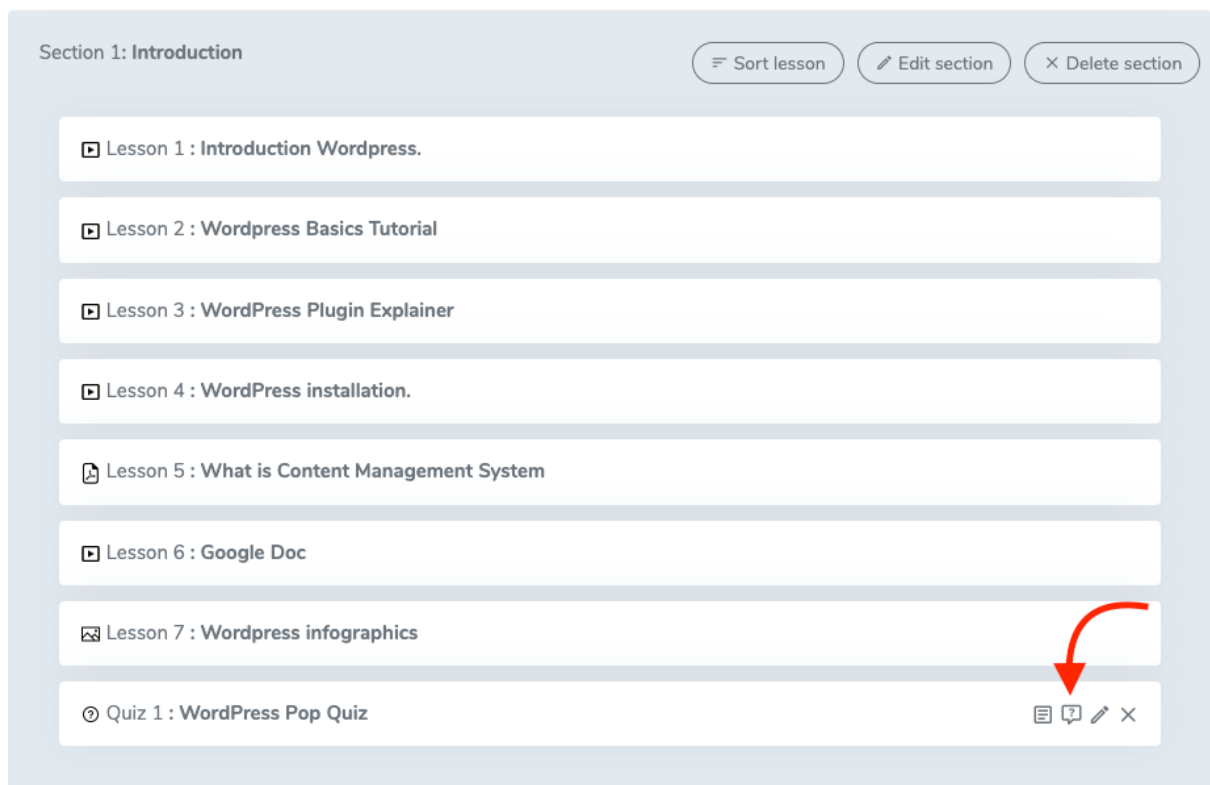


Figure 12. University of Technology LMS Quiz Question

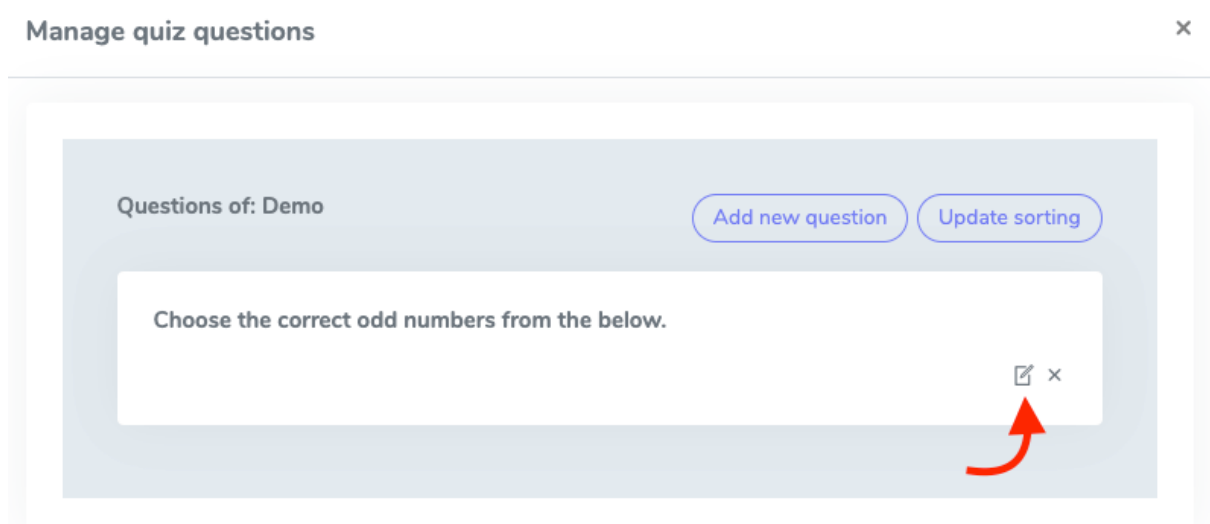


Figure 13. University of Technology LMS Updating Quiz Question

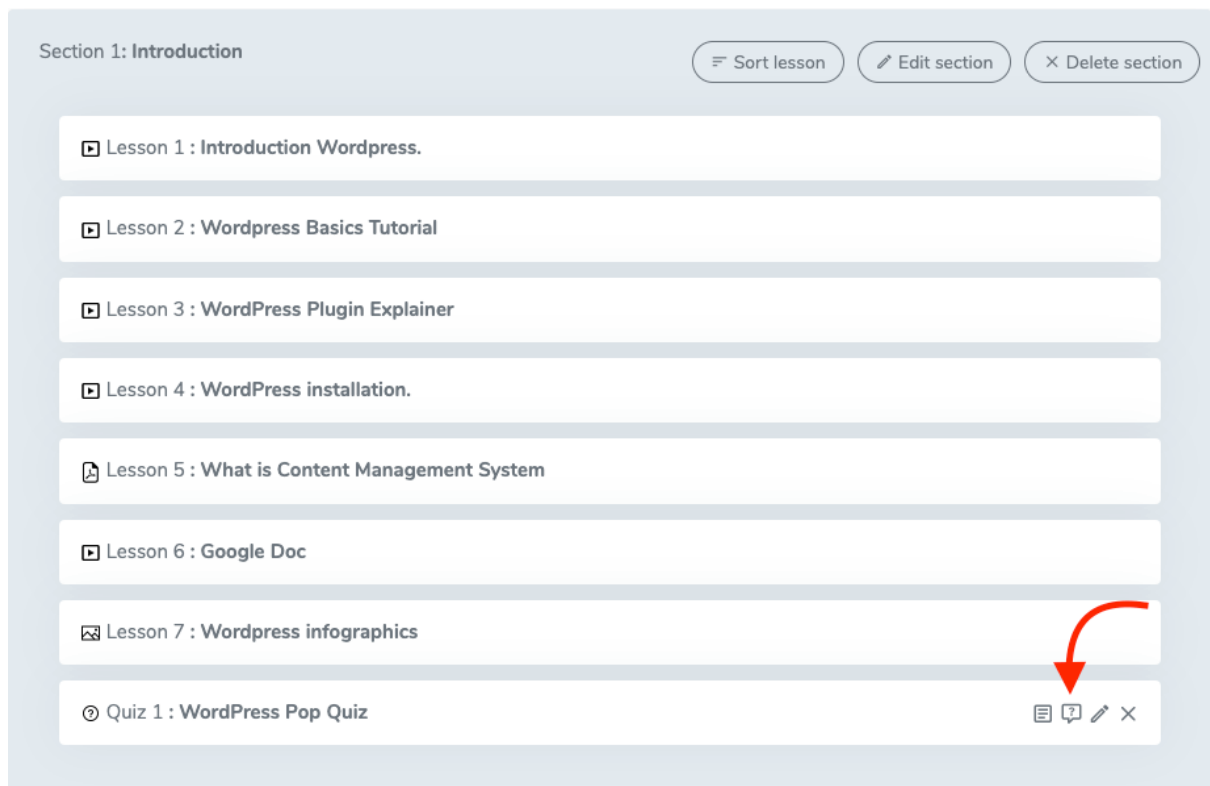


Figure 15. University of Technology LMS Quiz Question

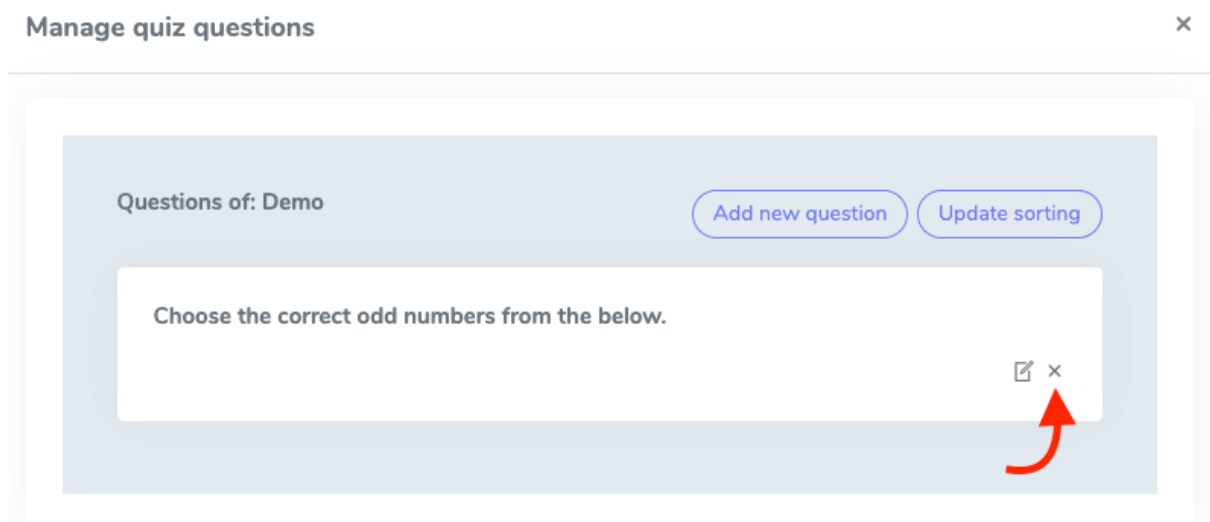


Figure 16. University of Technology LMS Deleting A Quiz Question

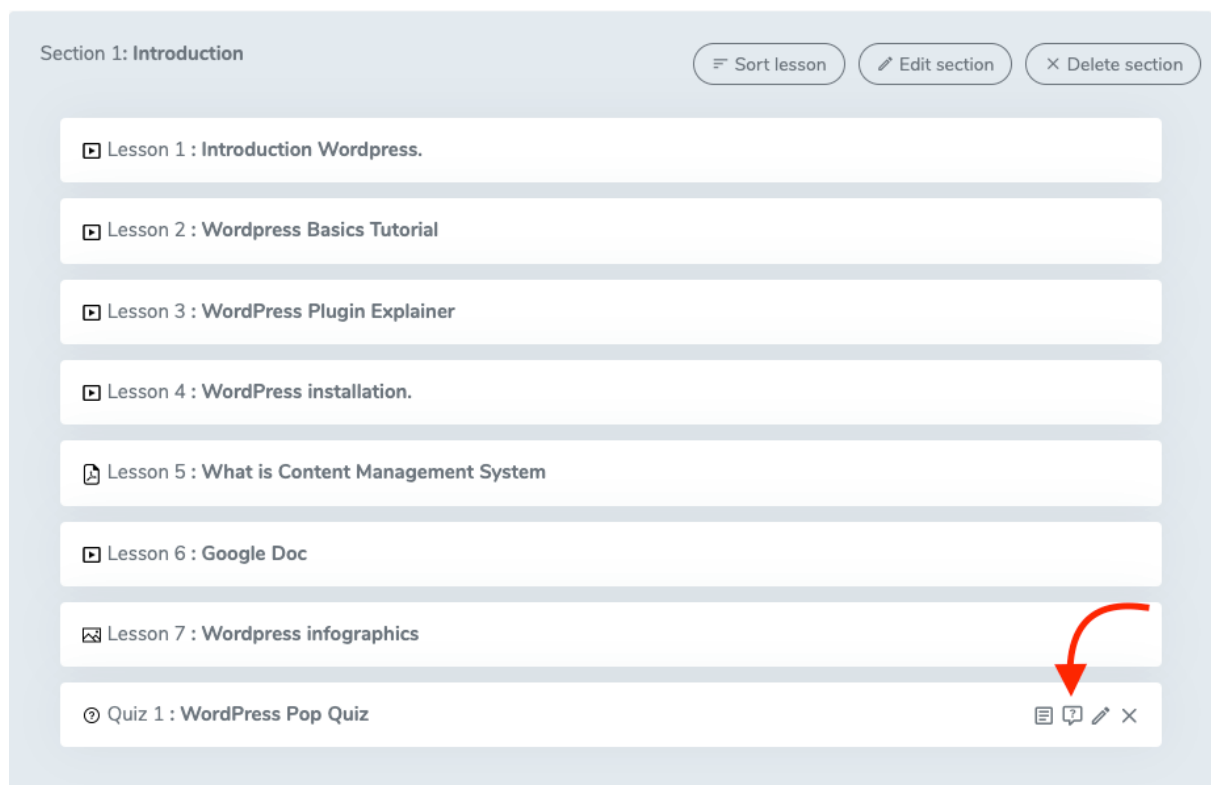


Figure 17. University of Technology LMS Quiz Question

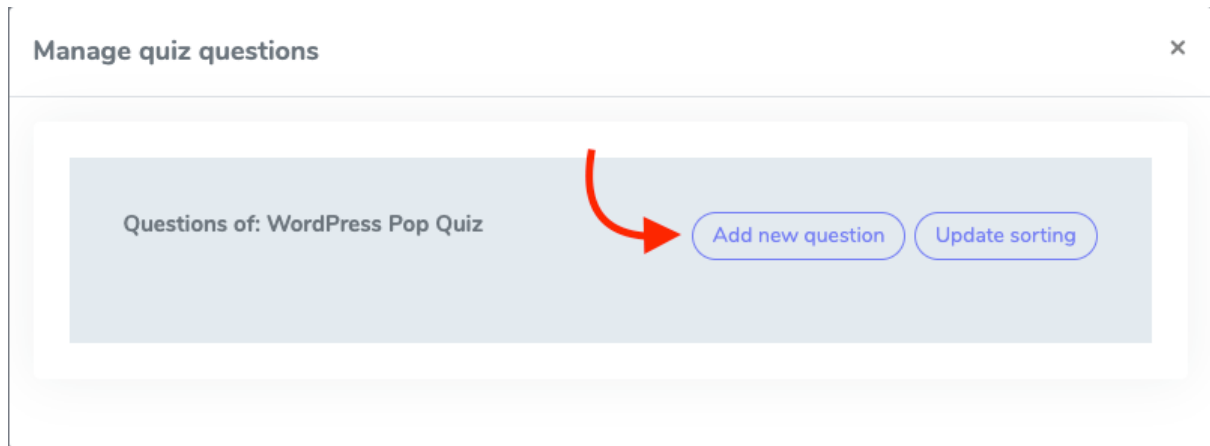


Figure 18. University of Technology LMS Adding New Quiz Question

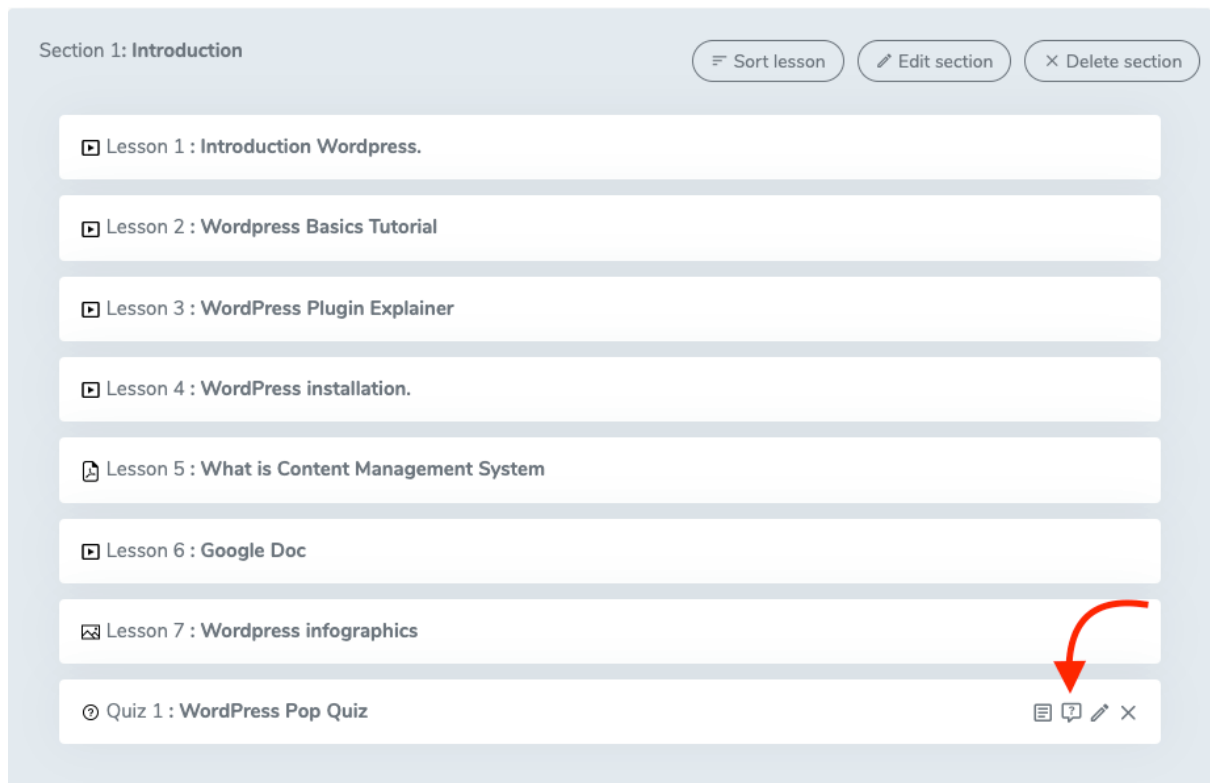
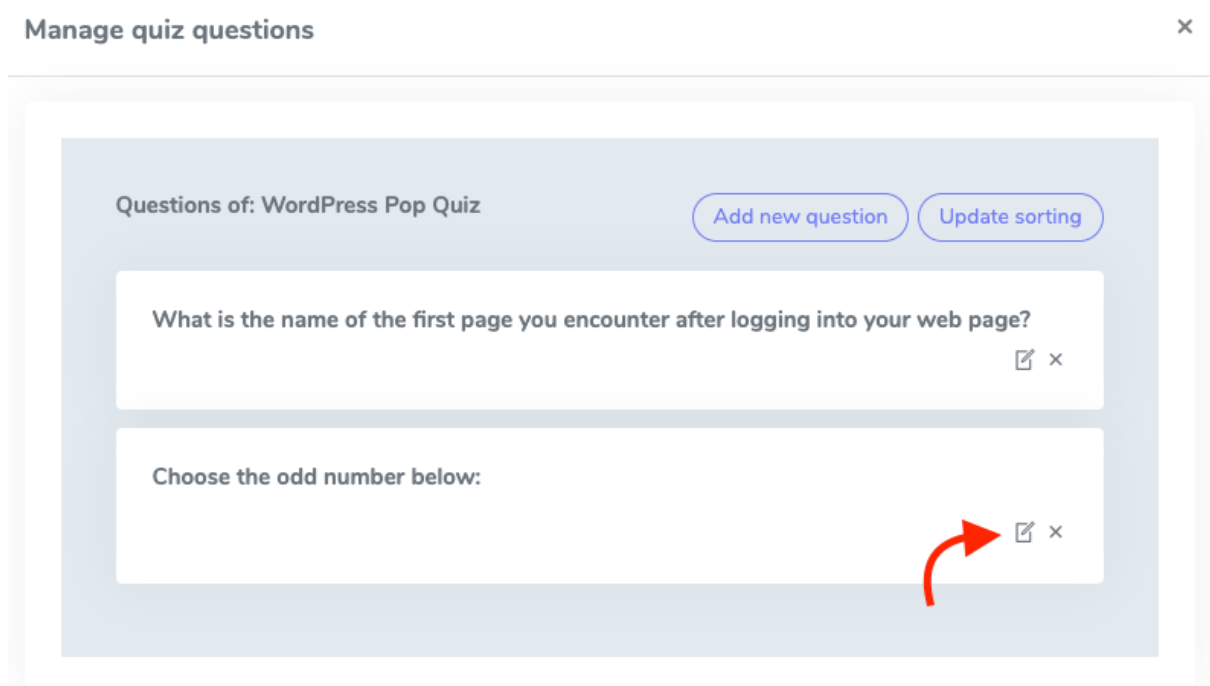


Figure 23. University of Technology LMS Quiz Question

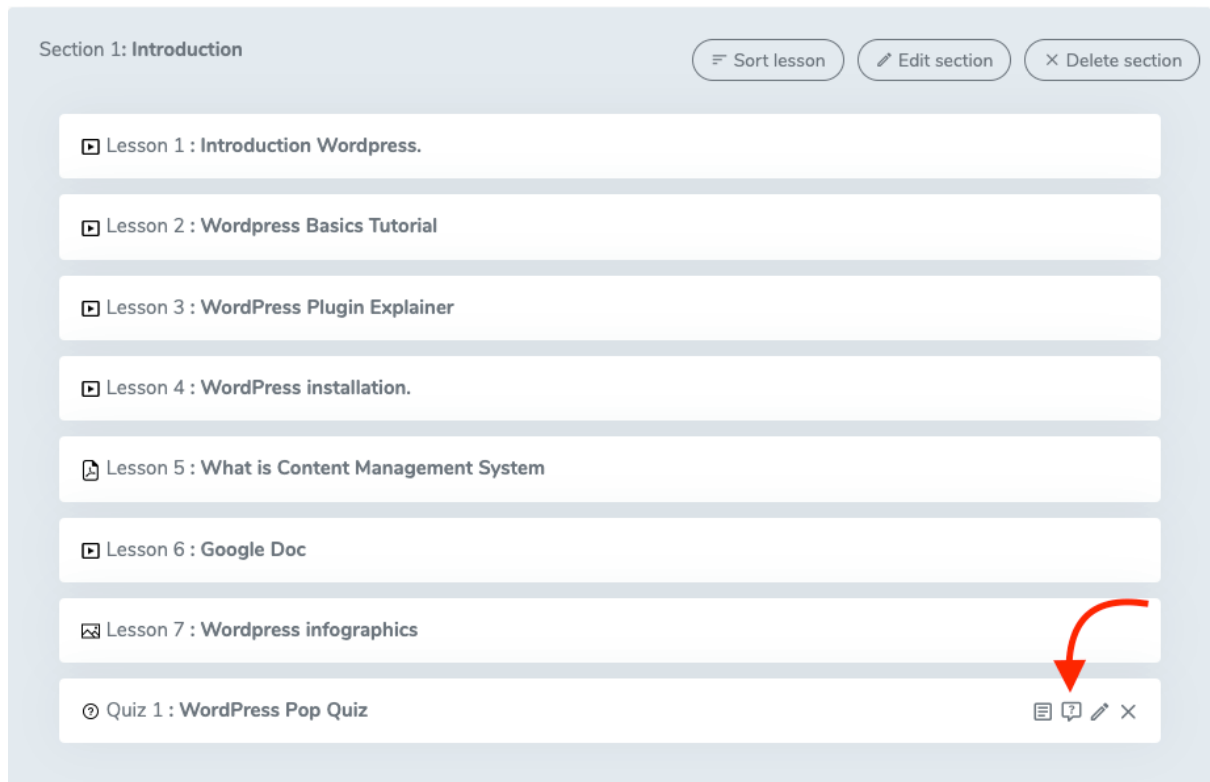


Figure 26. University of Technology LMS Quiz Question

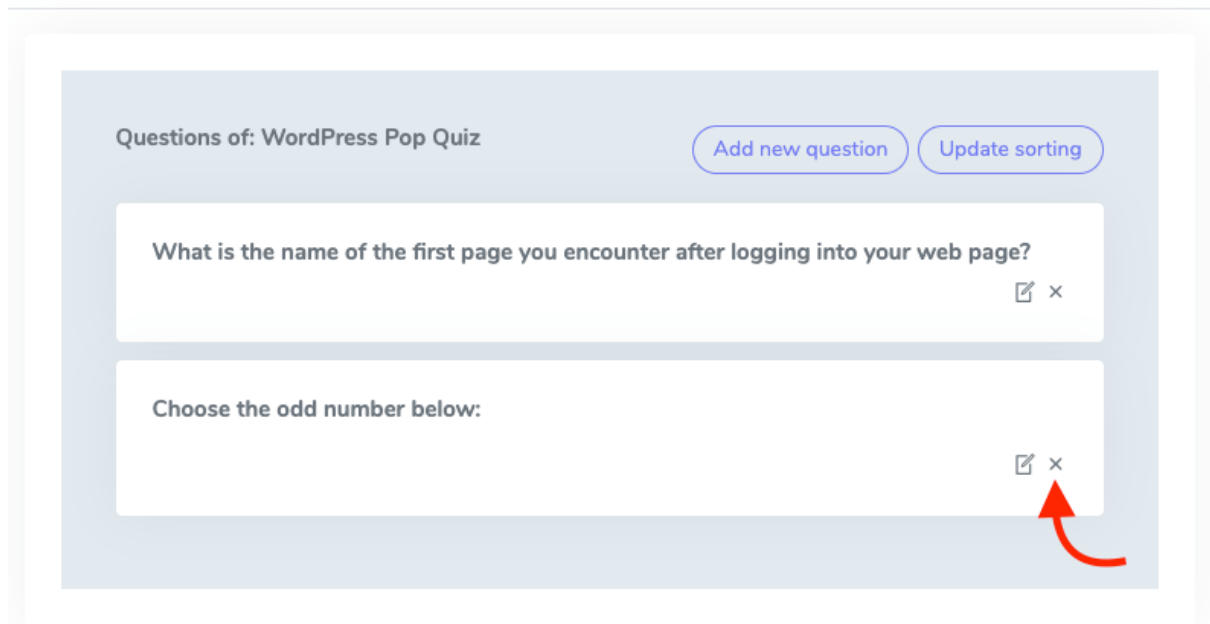


Figure 27. University of Technology LMS Deleting A Quiz Question

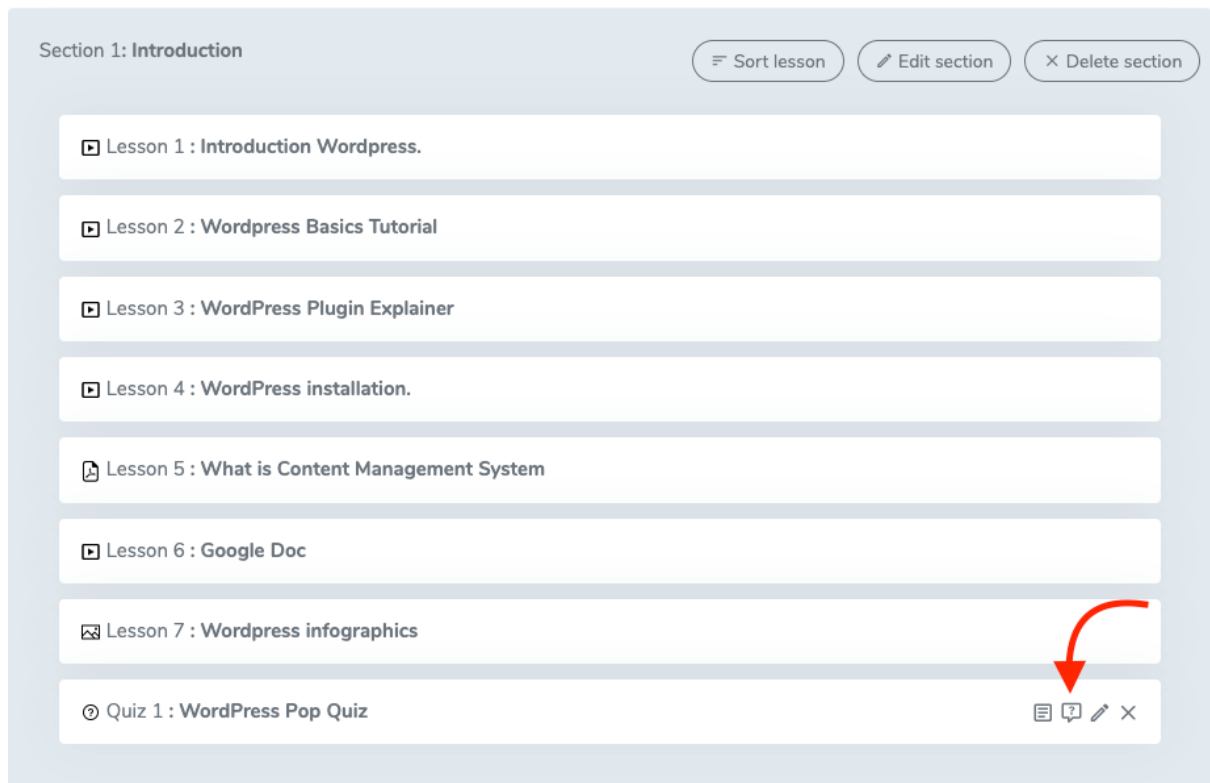


Figure 28. University of Technology LMS Quiz Question

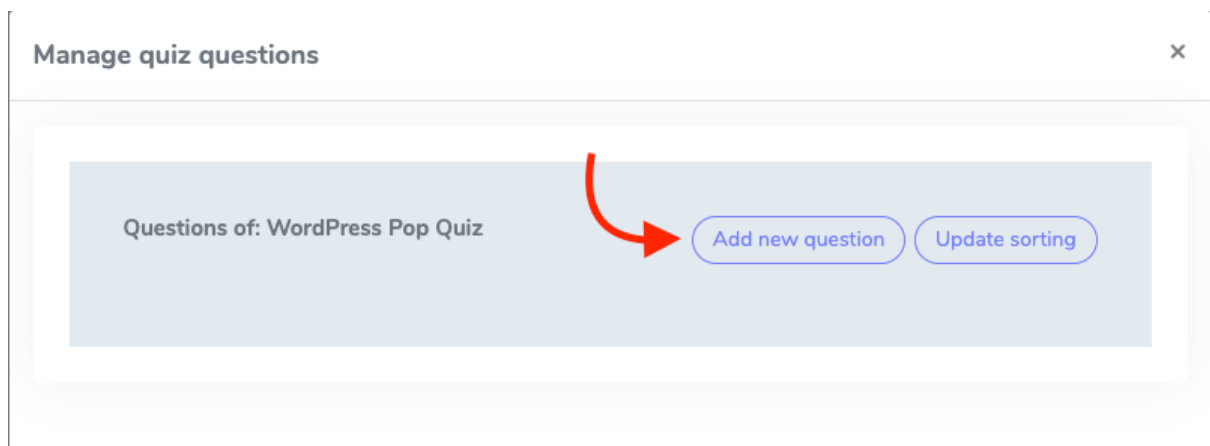


Figure 29. University of Technology LMS Adding New Quiz Question

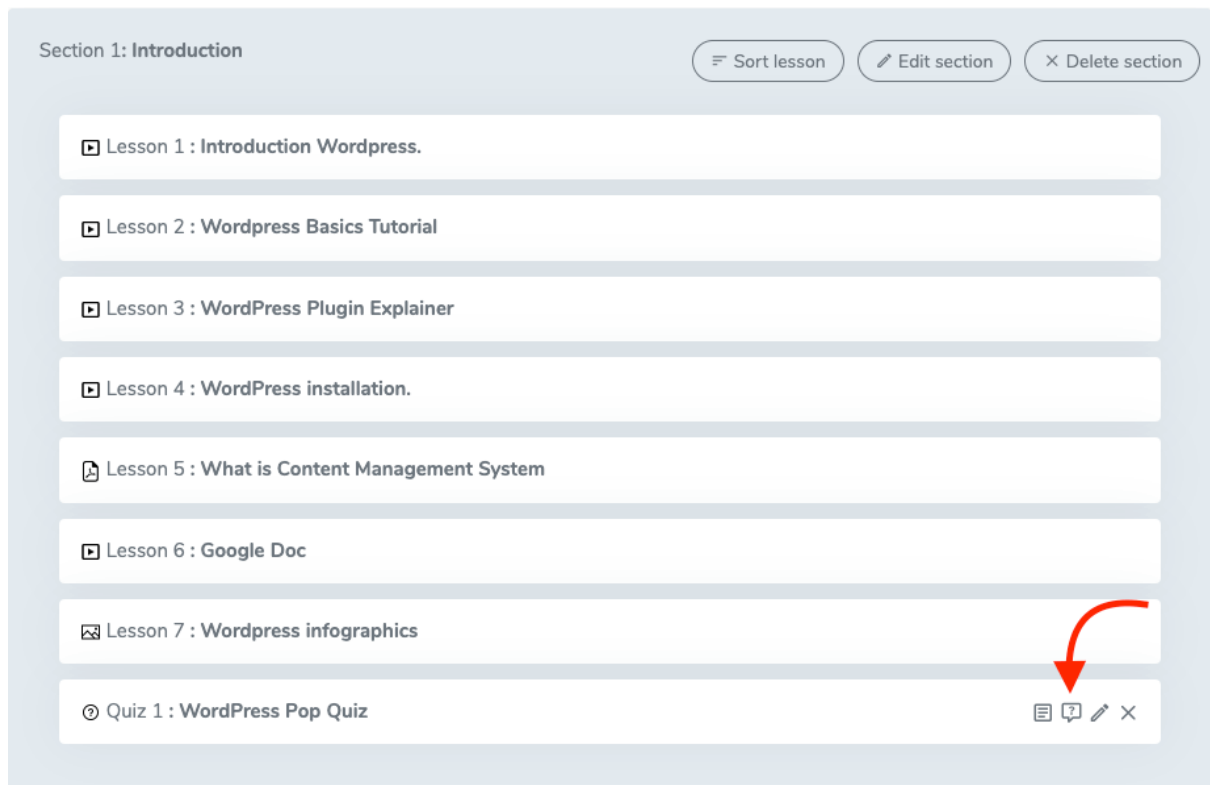


Figure 33. University of Technology LMS Quiz Question

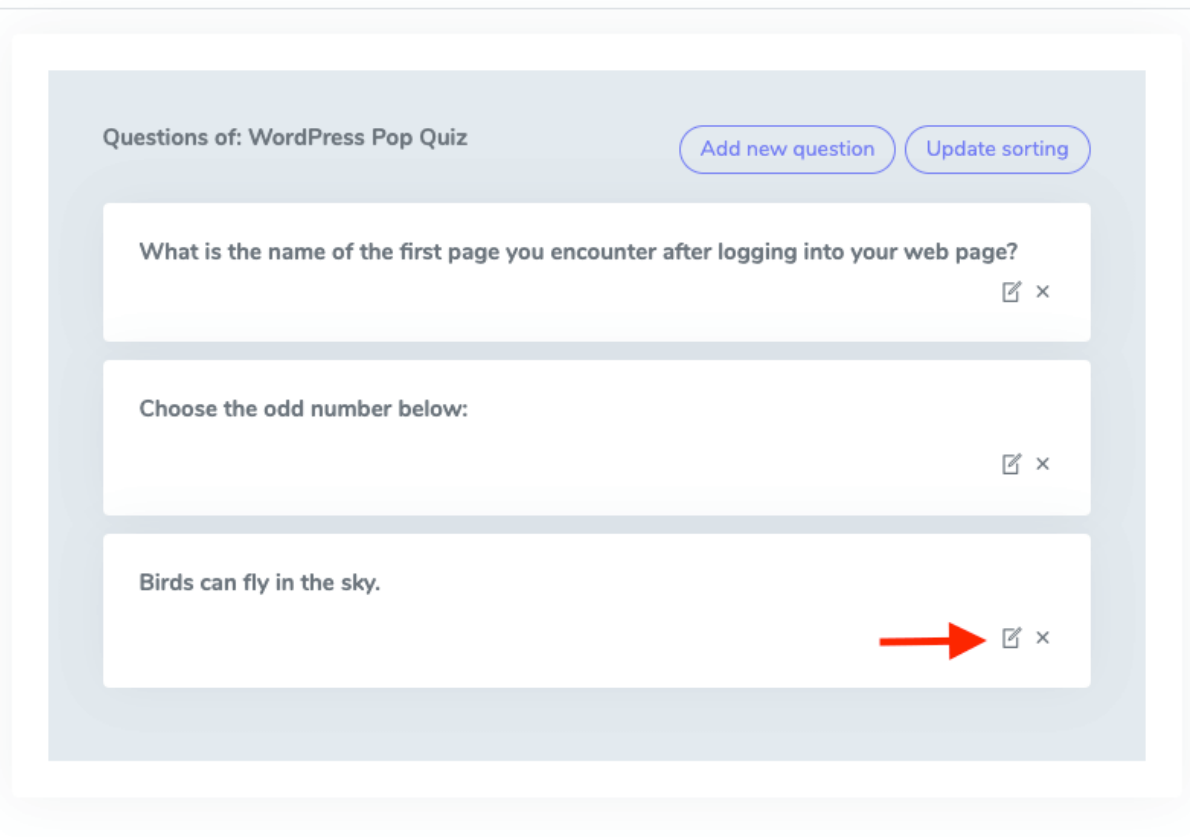


Figure 34. University of Technology LMS Updating Quiz Question

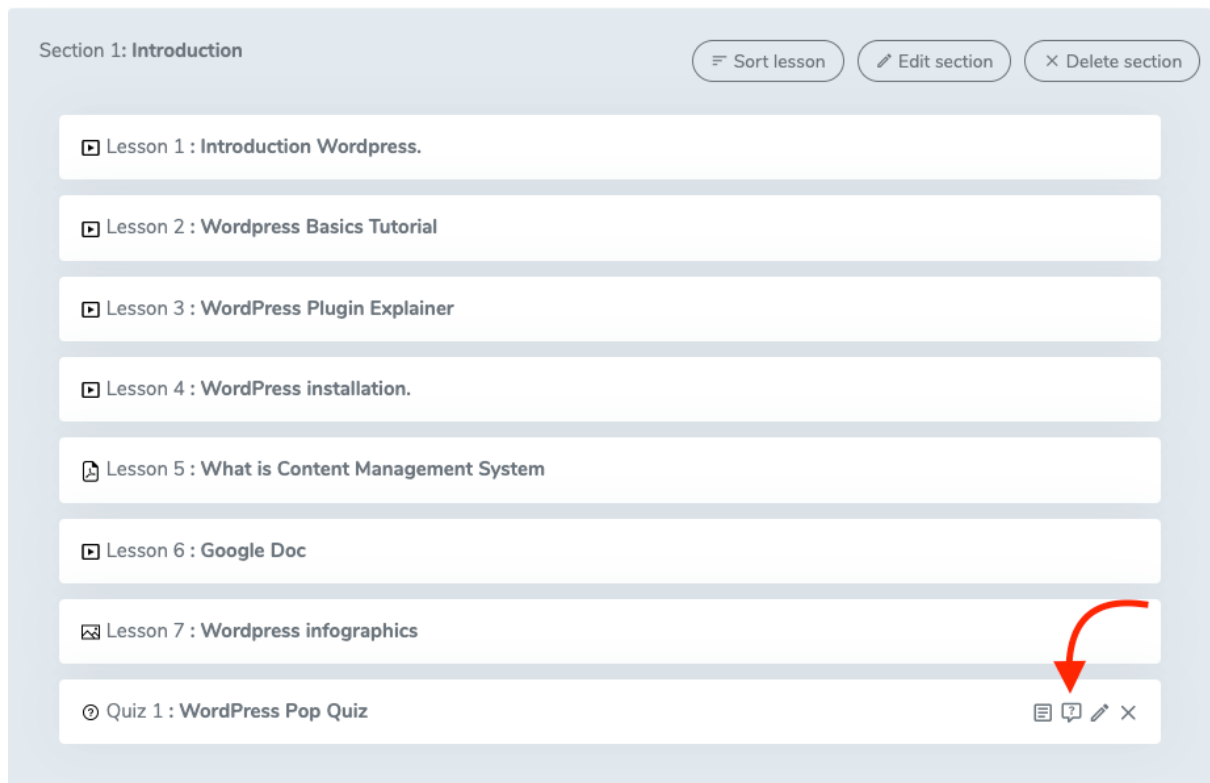


Figure 36. University of Technology LMS Quiz Question

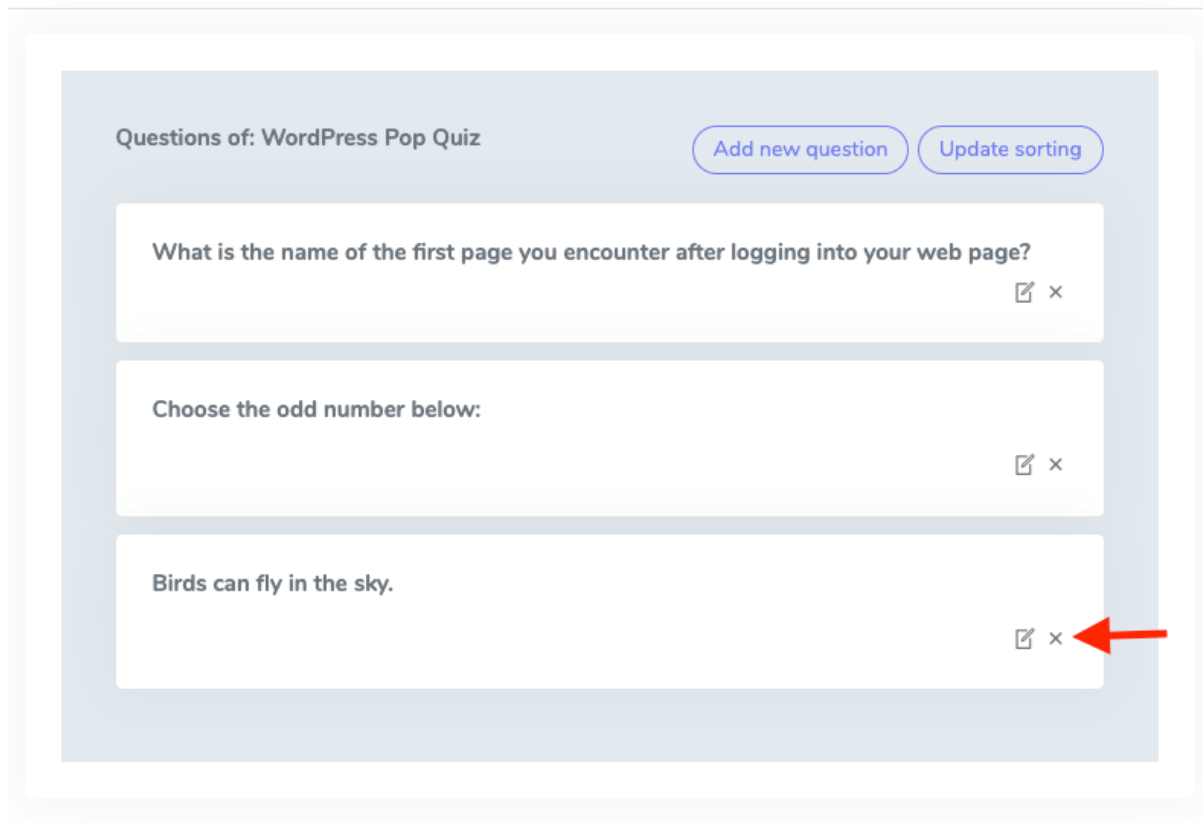


Figure 37. University of Technology LMS Deleting A Quiz Question

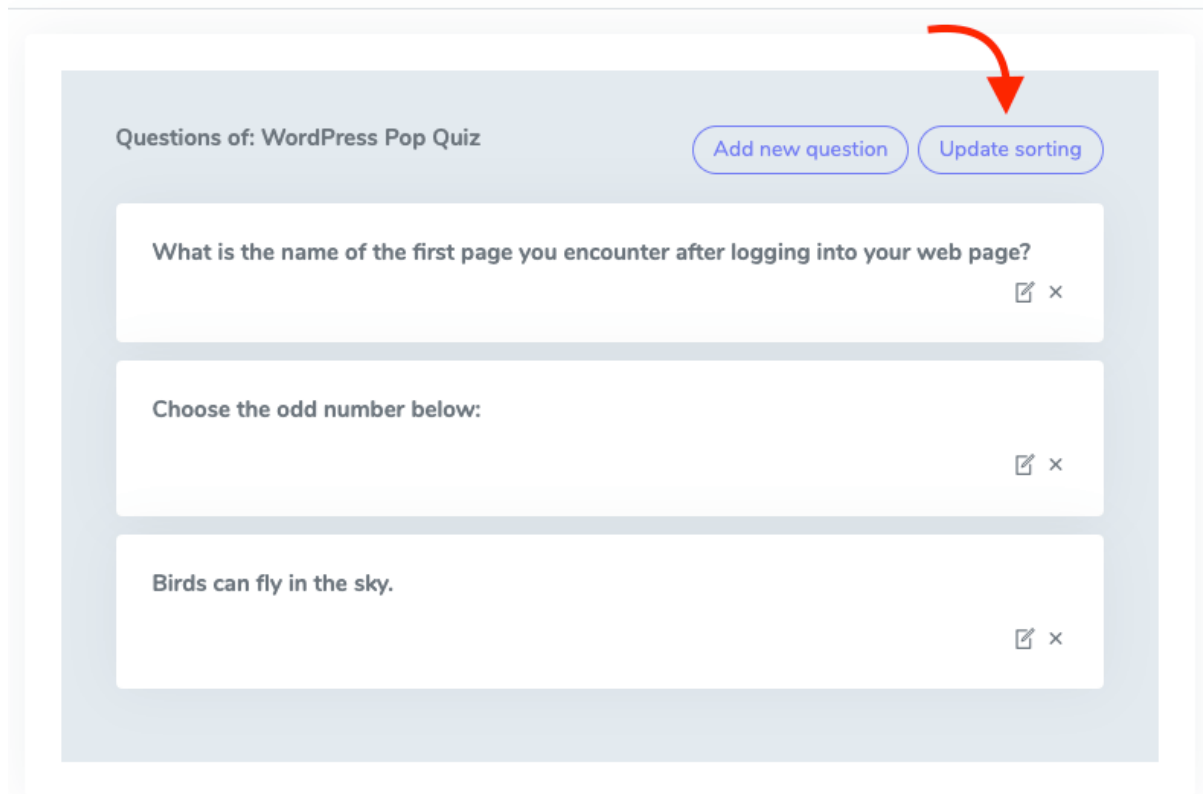


Figure 38. University of Technology LMS Sorting Quiz Question

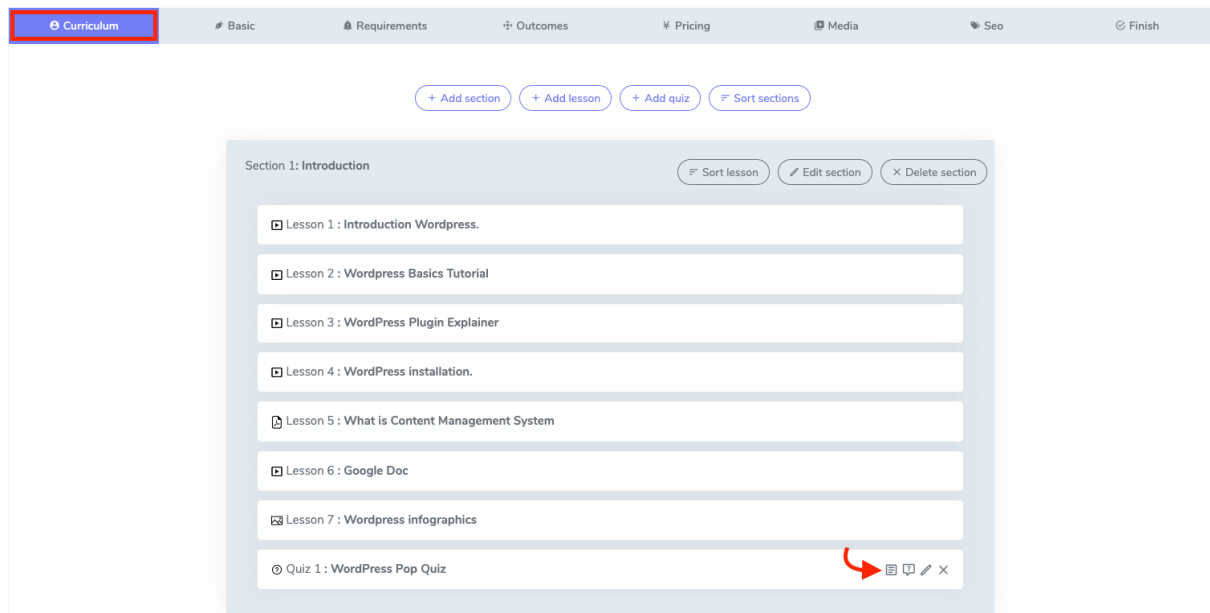


Figure 39. University of Technology LMS Quiz Result

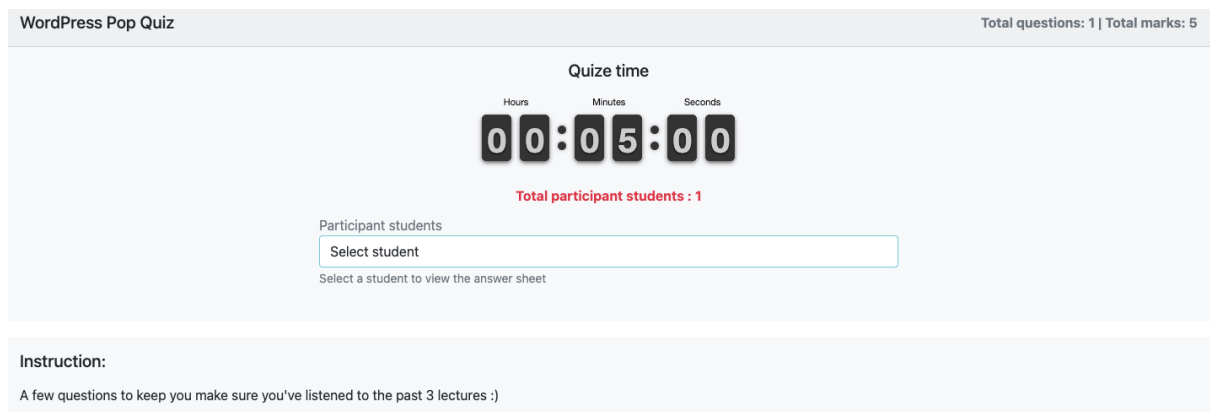


Figure 40. University of Technology LMS Selecting A Student

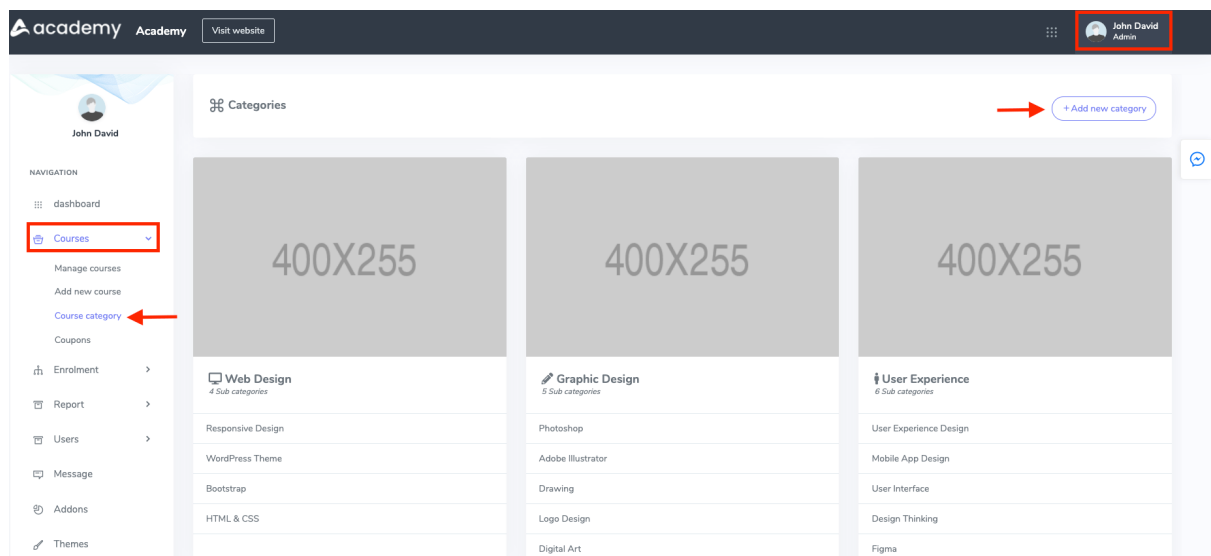


Figure 1. University of Technology LMS Adding Course Category

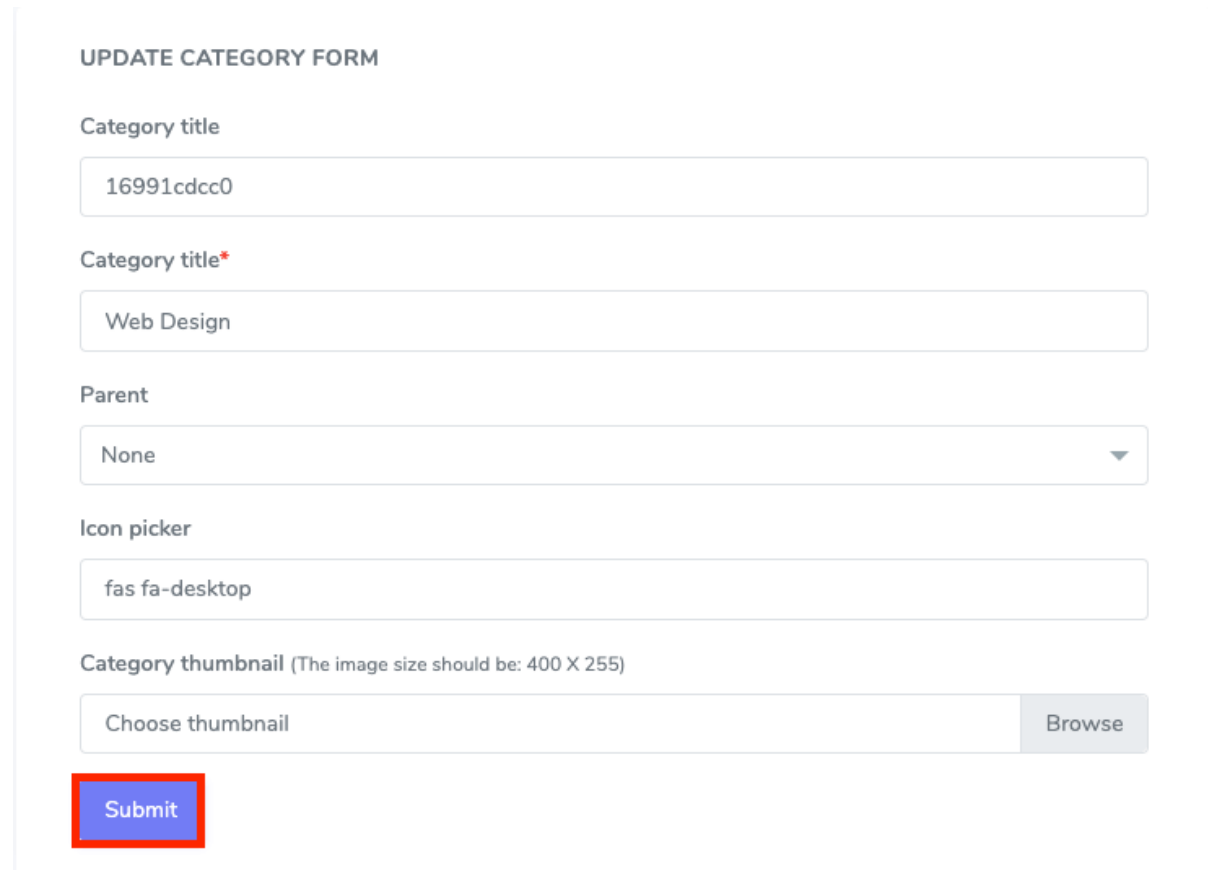

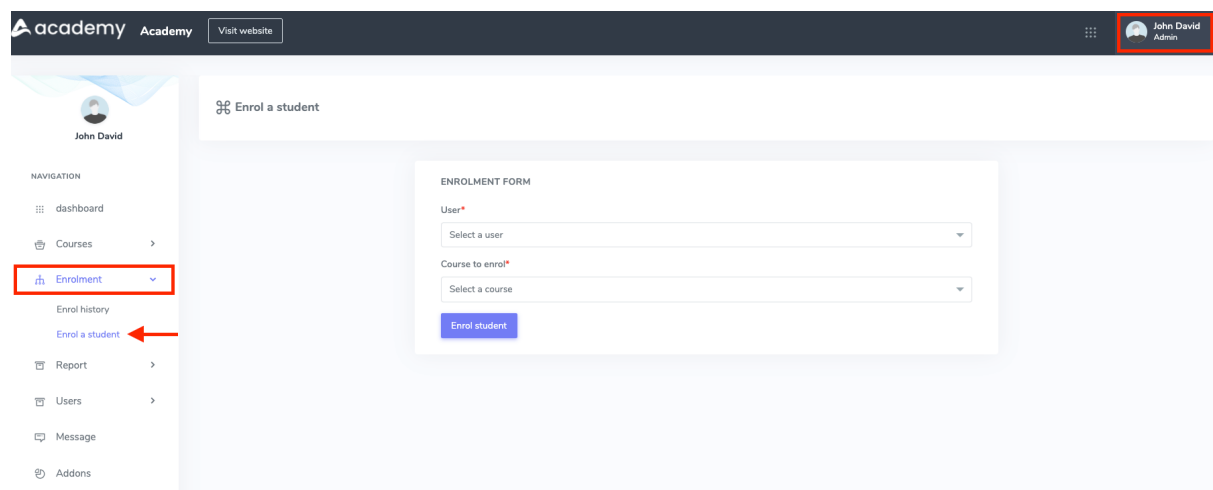


Figure 1. University of Technology LMS Enrolling a Student Manually

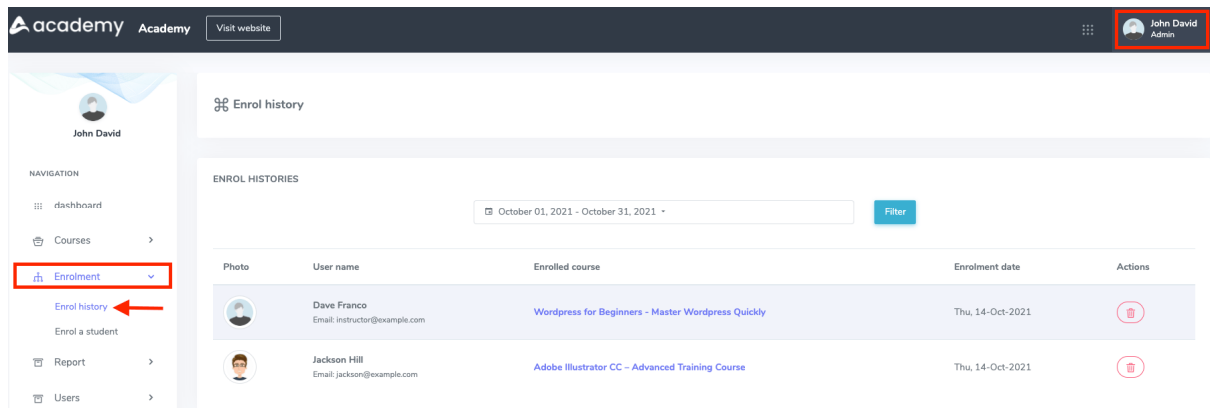


Figure 4. University of Technology LMS Enrolment History

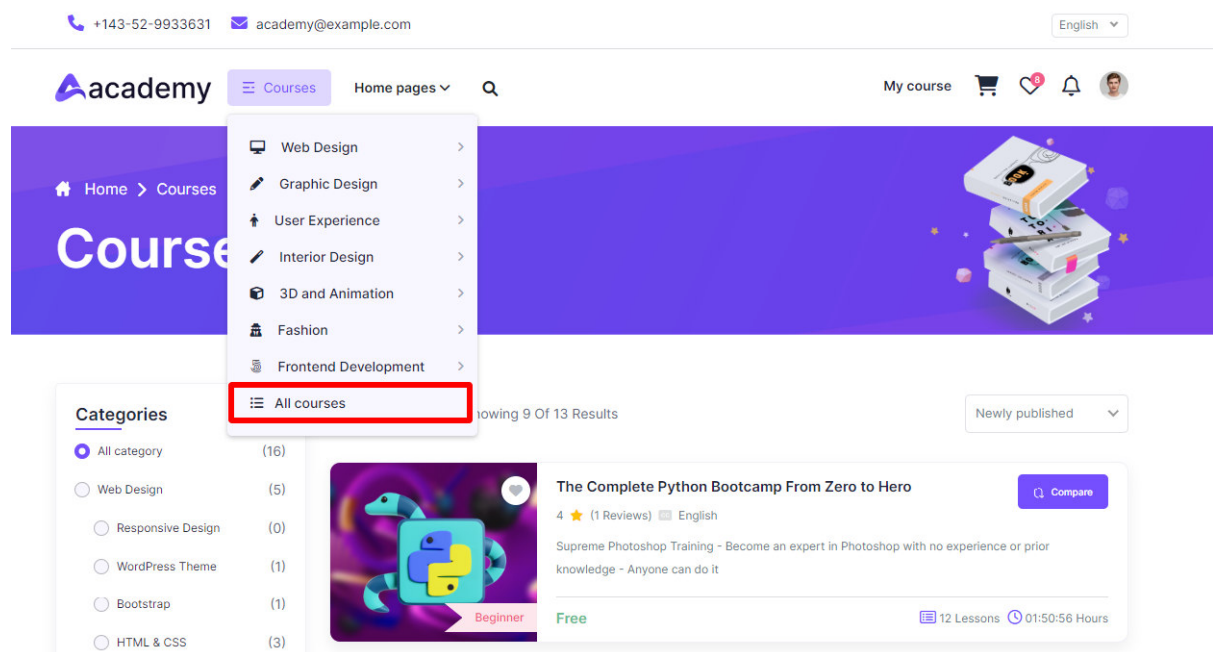


Figure 1. University of Technology LMS Course Browsing

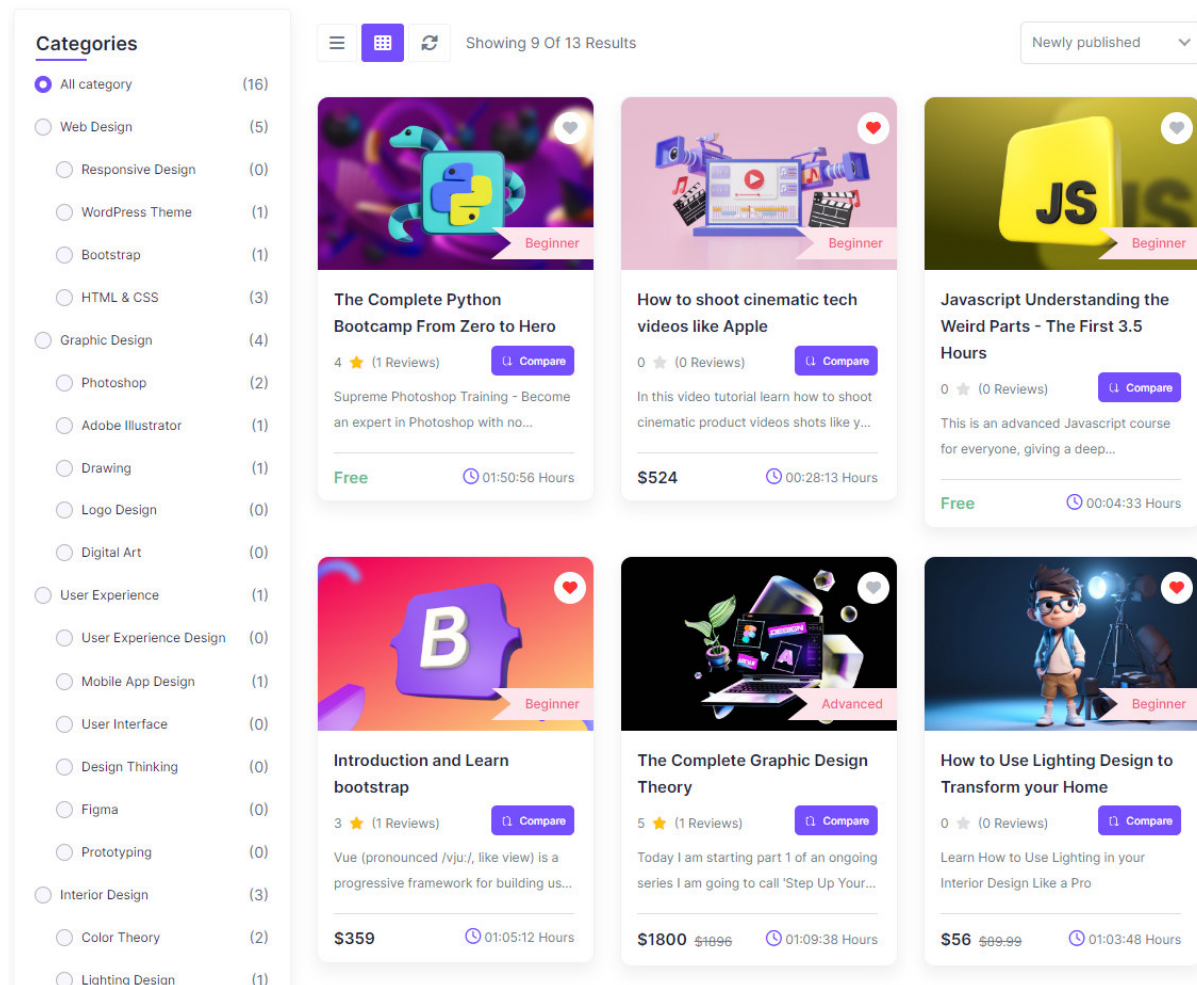


Figure 2. University of Technology LMS Filtering the Course

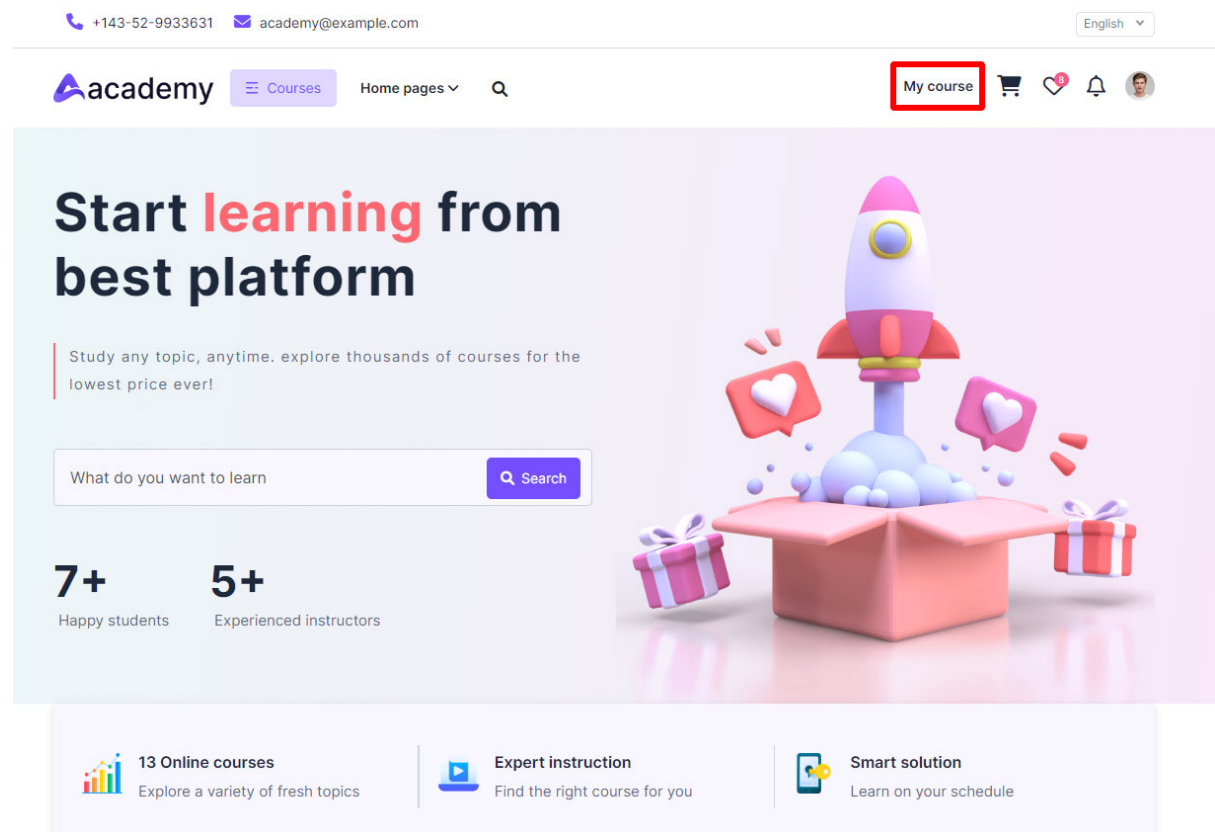


Figure 1. University of Technology LMS My Course

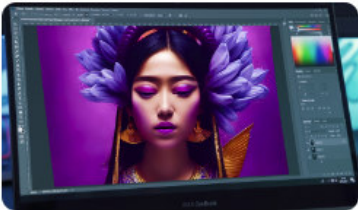

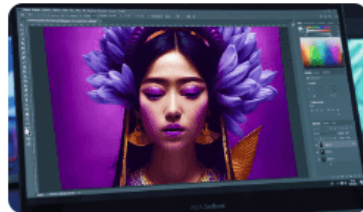

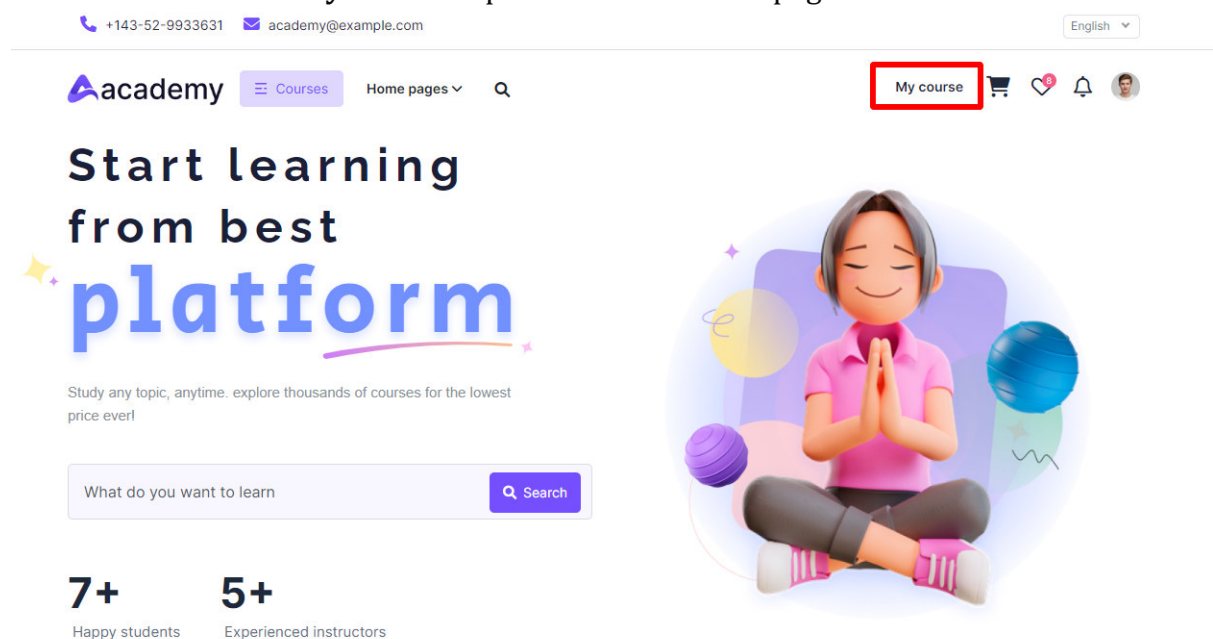


Figure 1. University of Technology LMS My Course

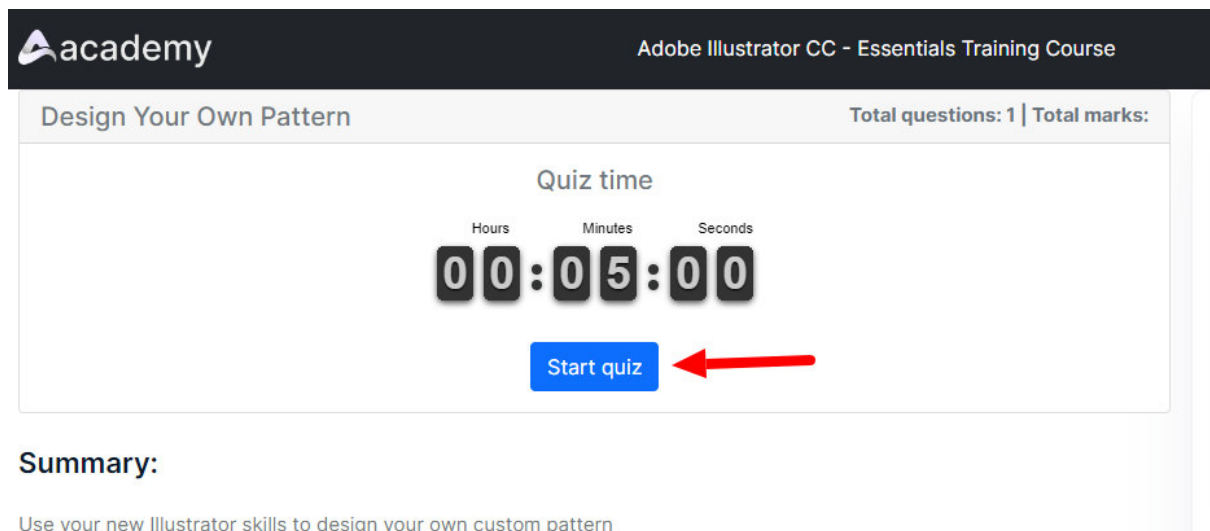


Figure 2. University of Technology LMS Starting Quiz

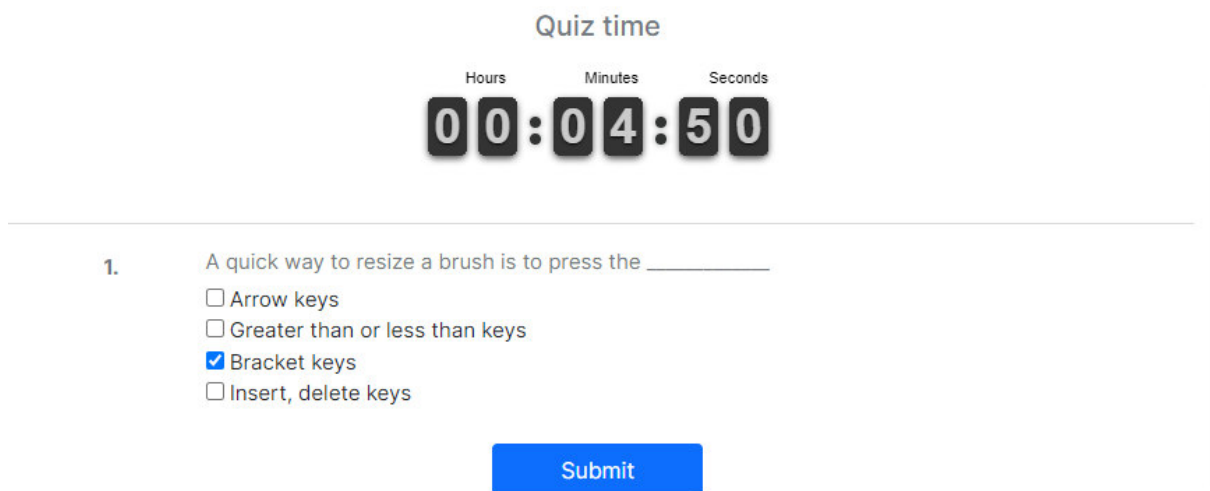


Figure 3. University of Technology LMS Submitting Quiz Test
